2) Informational News

Revisions to the Fair Labor Standards Act now require that non-exempt professional staff need to record all overtime hours on their time sheets. However, the Library has not budgeted for overtime compensation. Employees whose positions have been categorized as non-exempt (and are therefore eligible for overtime) should not be earning compensatory time except under special circumstances and with the approval of library administration.
