

Scientific Truth



Scientific truth is a statement of probability proportional to the evidence. It will change over time as the evidence changes.

Journalism and Science



Like scientists, journalists do not believe in absolute truth. Truth is *provisional*. It changes over time.



Journalism and Science



Like science, journalism employs a system of peer review.

Like the scientific method, the journalistic process of verification relies on a system of sorting and testing information
