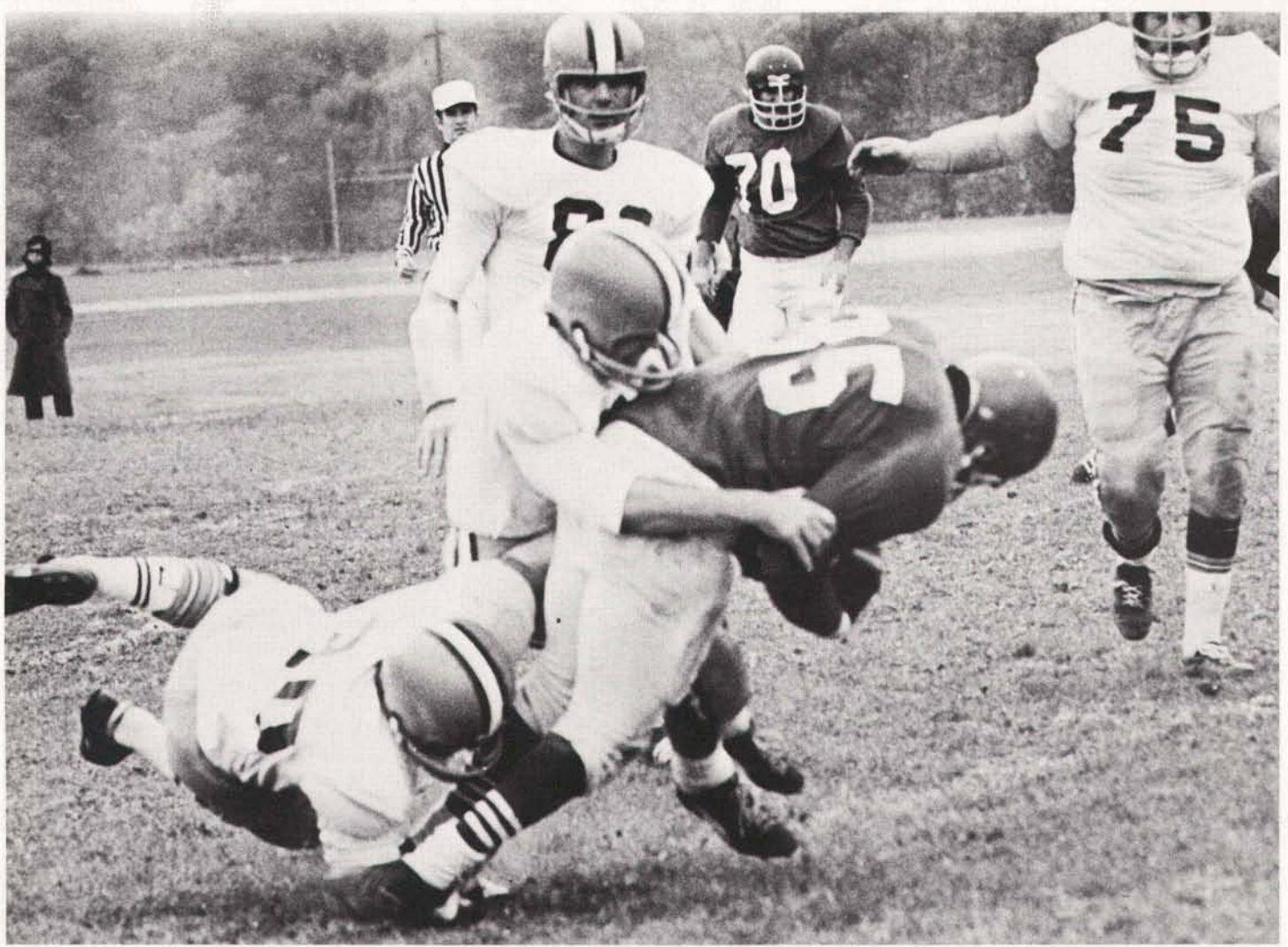








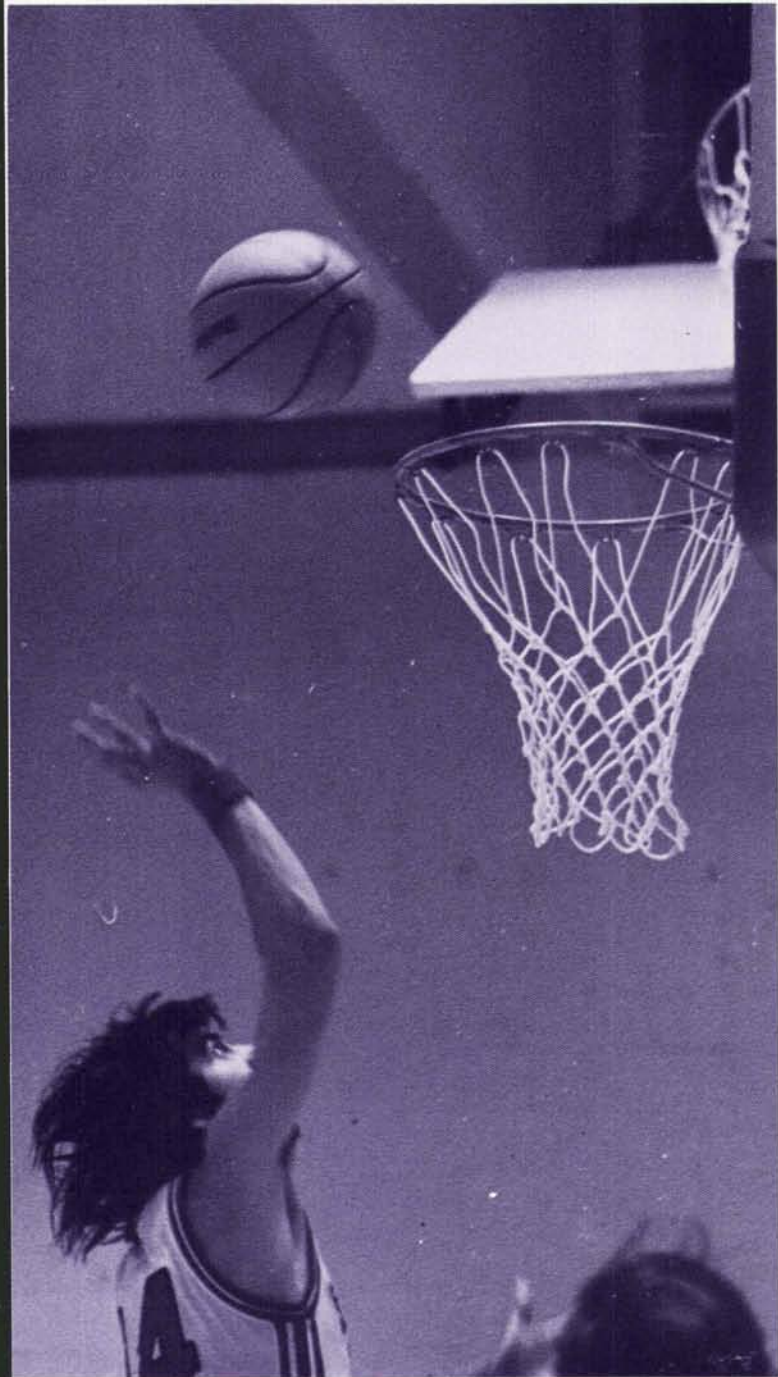
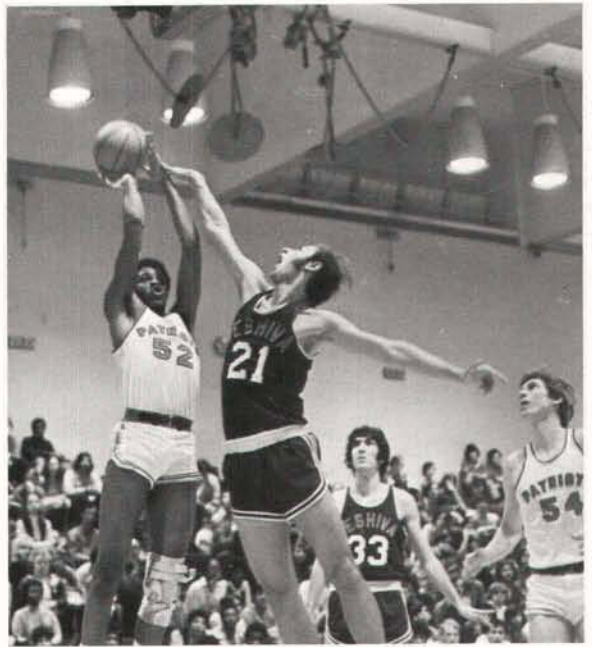




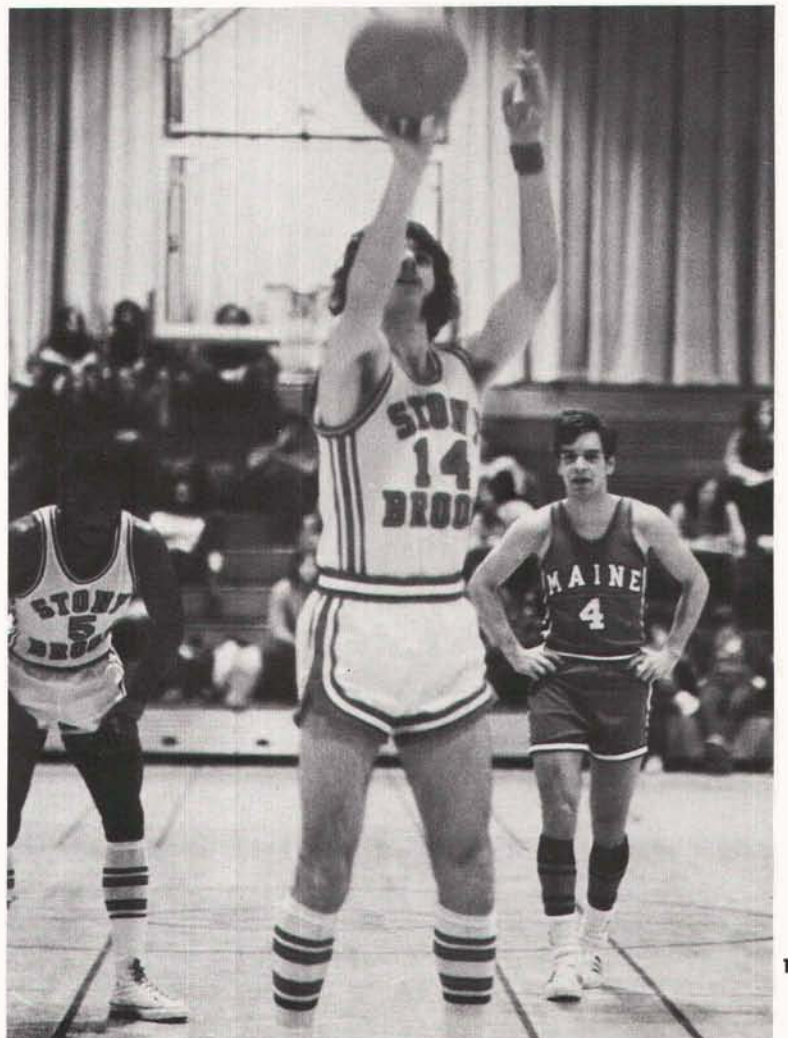
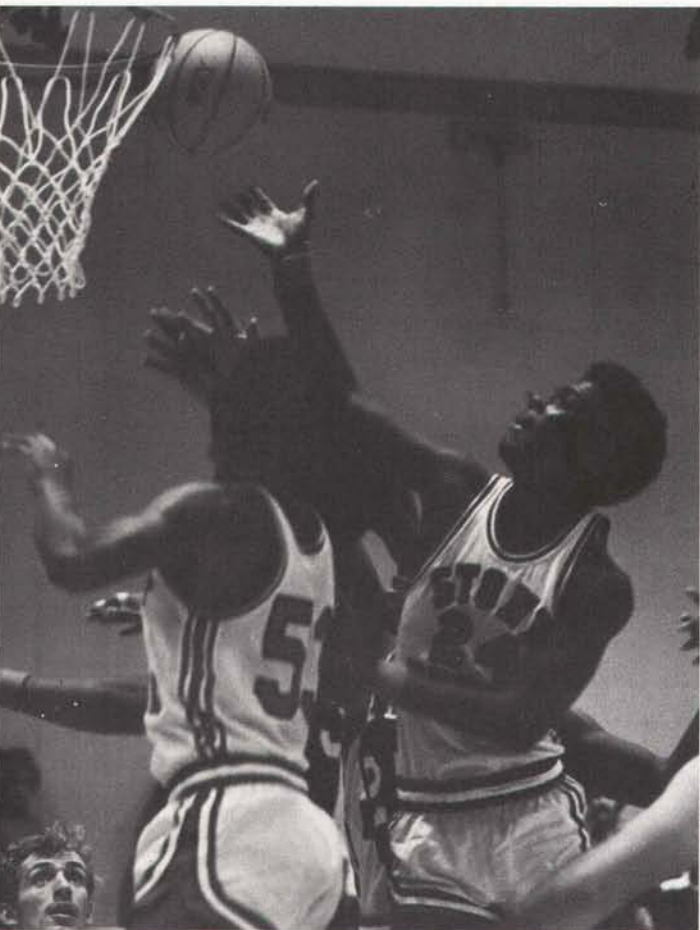
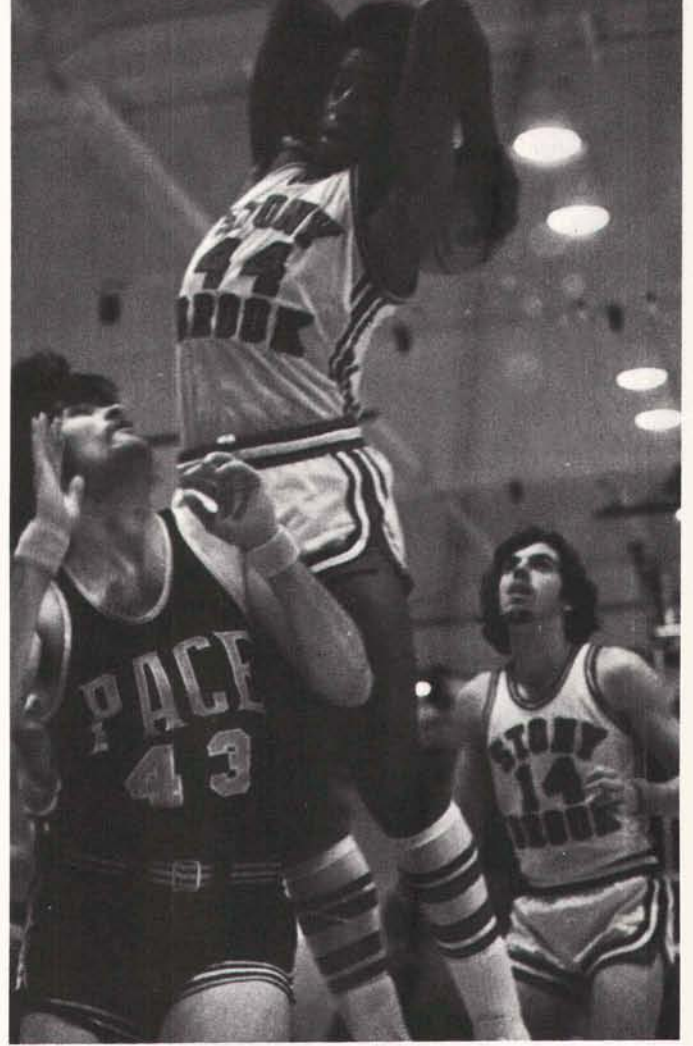


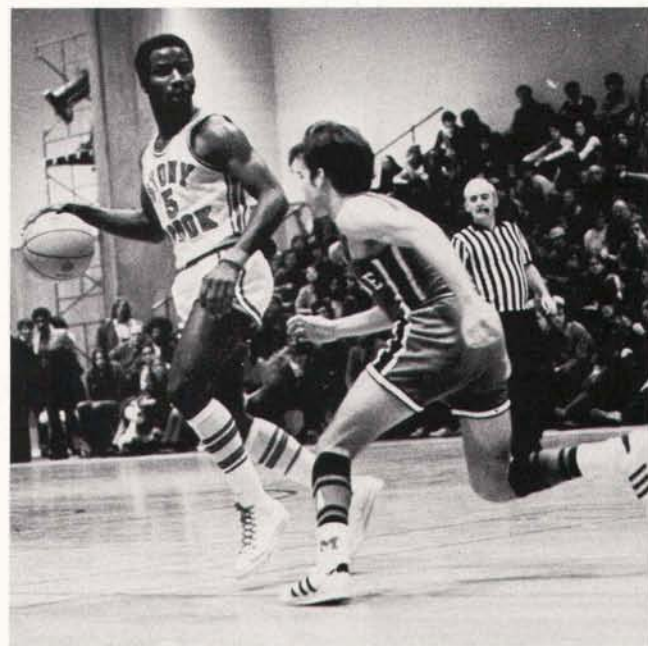
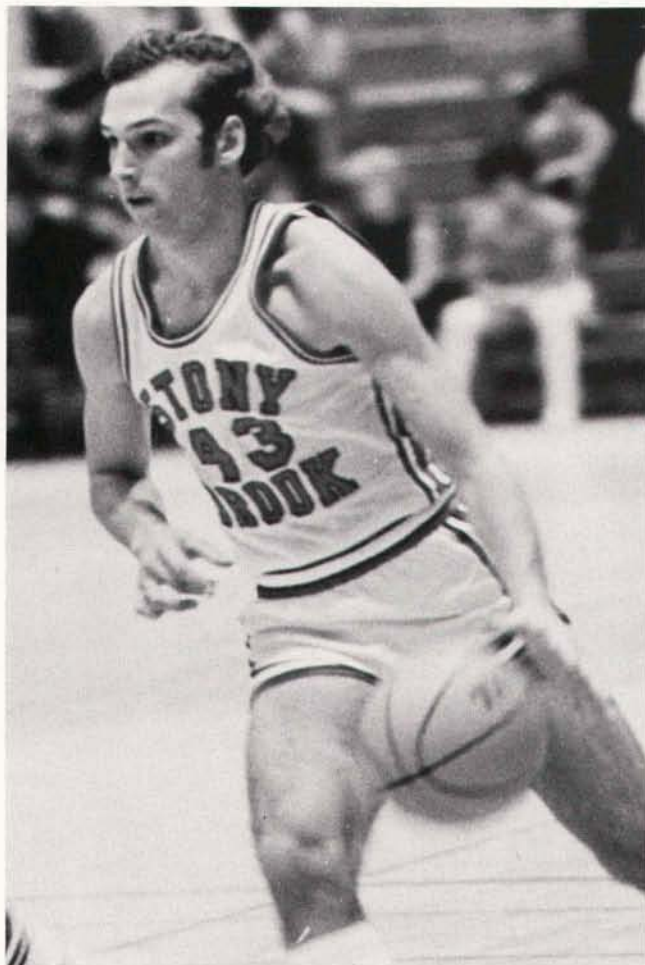
Finishing second in the Knickerbocker Conference, the Stony Brook Cagers showed a formidable team this year. Center Art King, setting a Stony Brook record for points scored in one season with 511, was named an All-Metropolitan player. He managed to do an excellent job filling in the gap at center which Mike Kerr left when he graduated. Bill Myrick finished his career with 1002 points, the most ever at Stony Brook. Donald Covaleski coached the team to a 16-10 record and a Long Island Schaefer Tournament win.

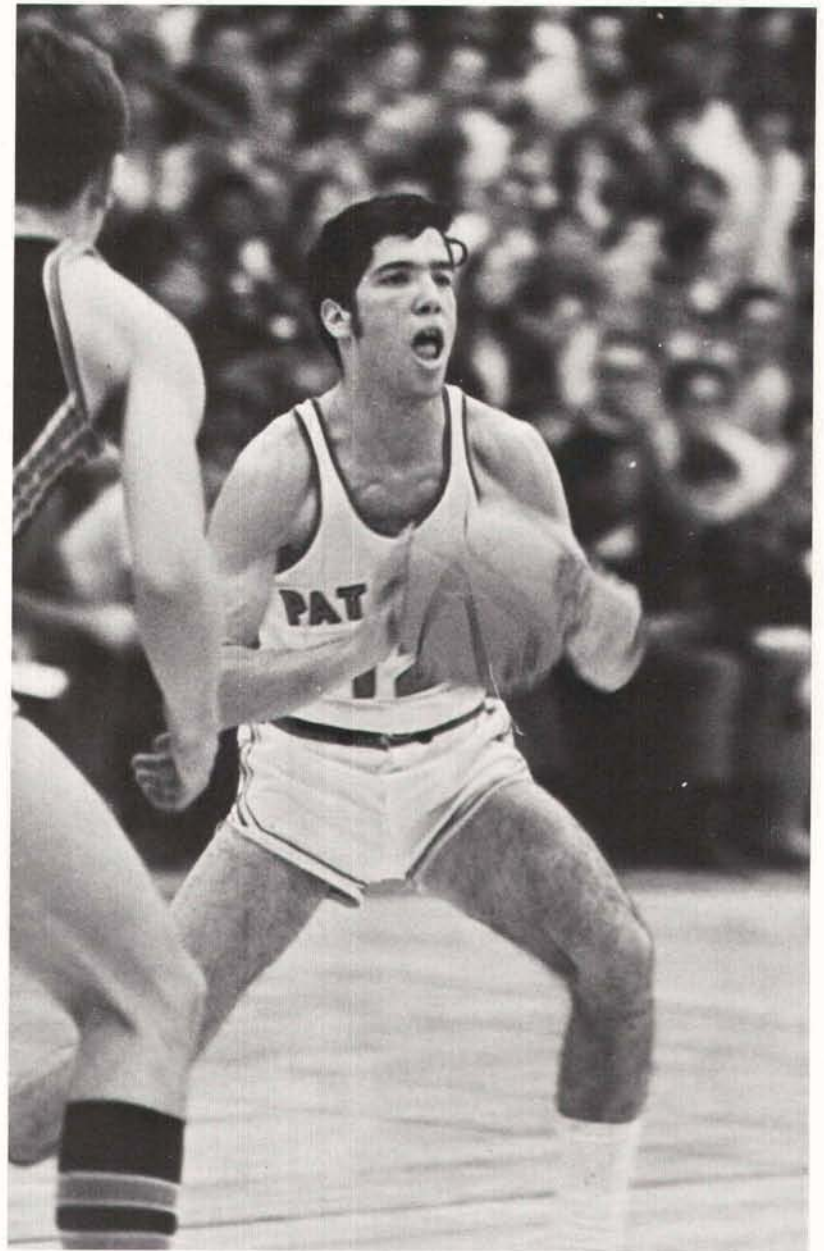
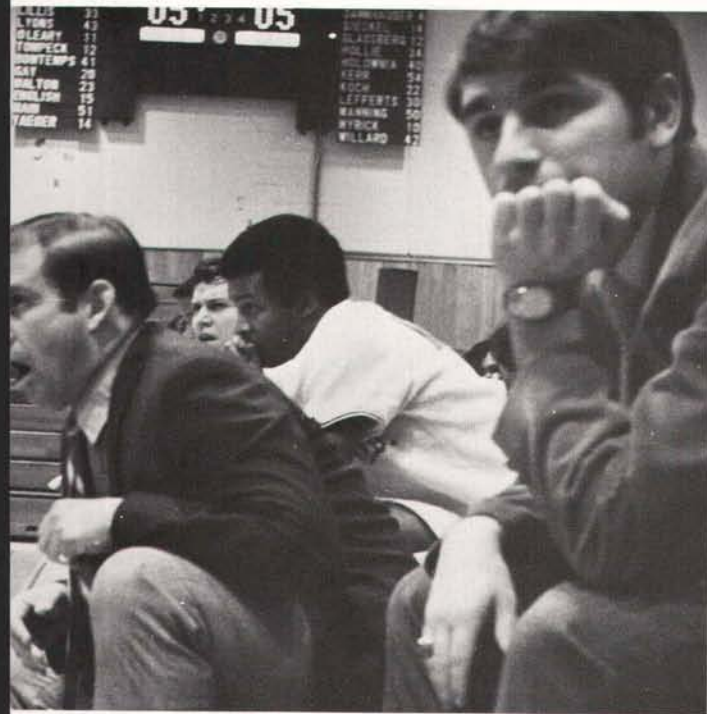






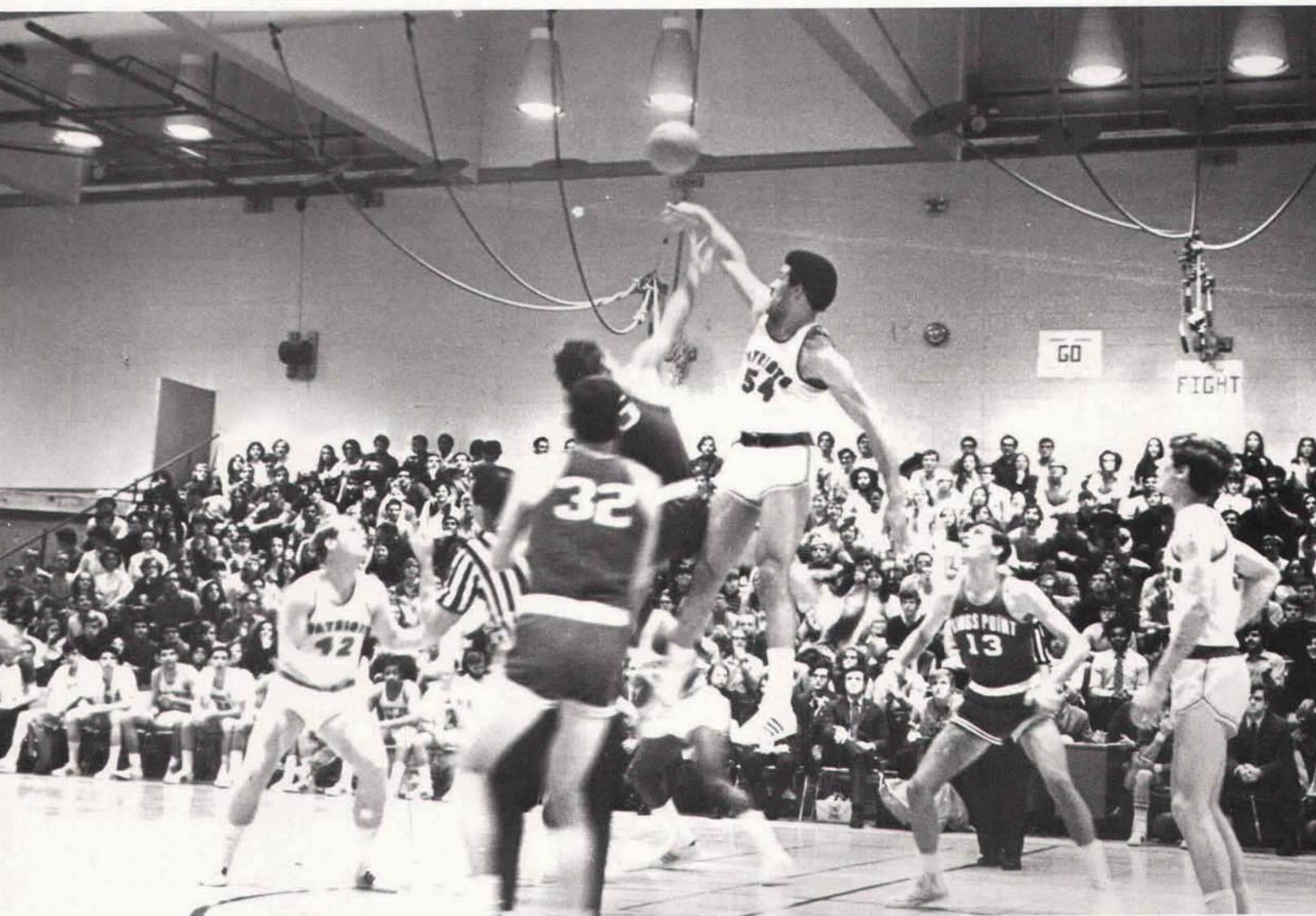




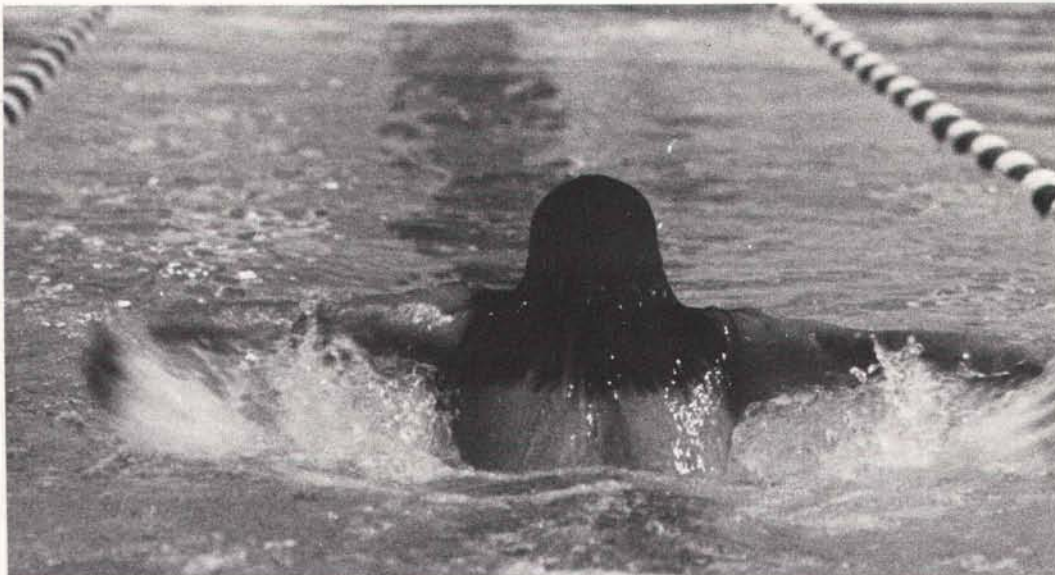
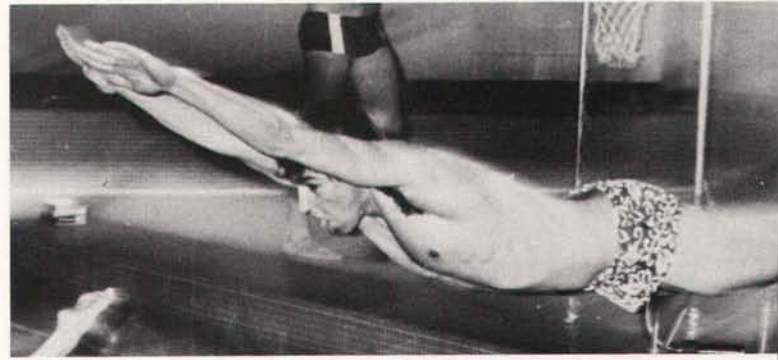


Led by Mike Kerr, the 1969-70 Stony Brook team won first place in the Knickerbocker Conference. That year the Patriots set a record with 18 wins including 11 in a row. Kerr still owns the records of most career rebounds and highest percentage of free throws.

Coach Massimino's success with this team earned him a position with the University of Pennsylvania's basketball team.



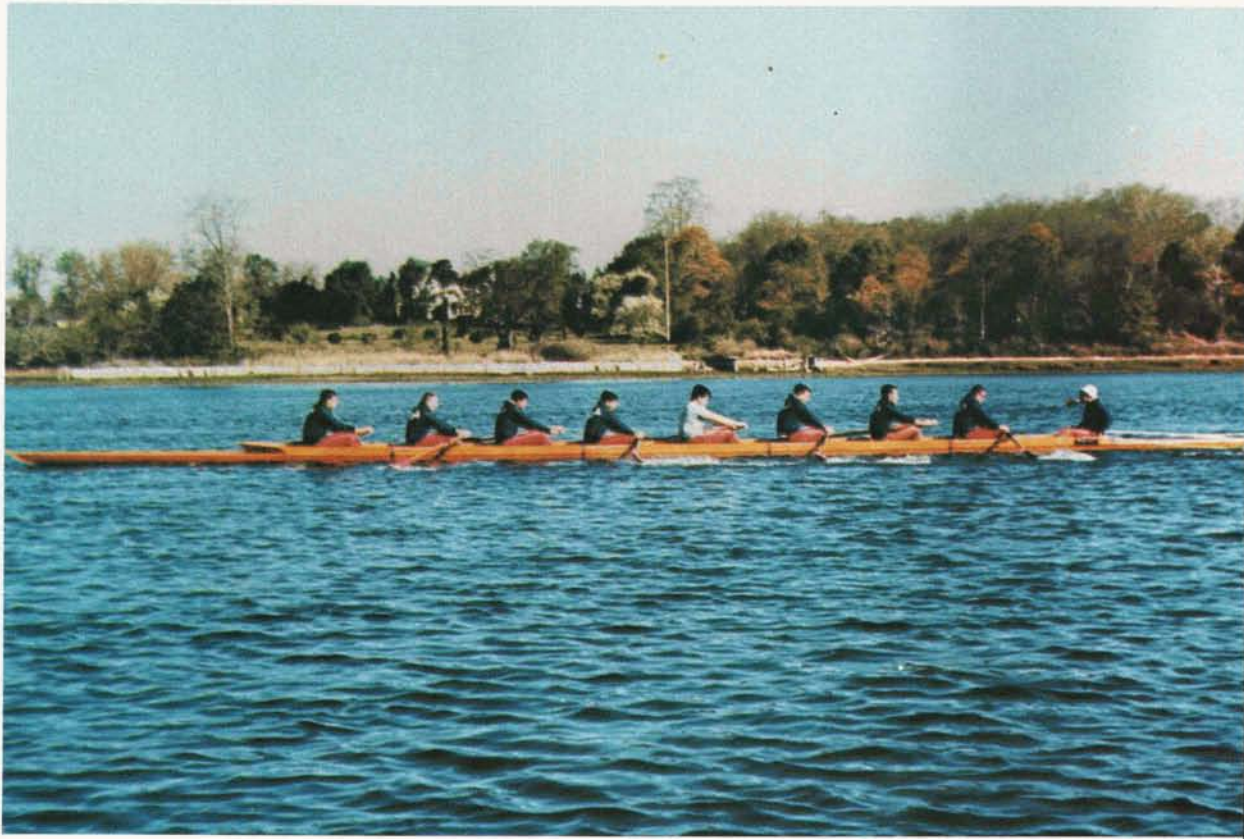

Smoliak's enthusiasm still persists as he strives to put Stony Brook on the baseball map. He has found more ball-players for next year and is optimistic about the forthcoming season.







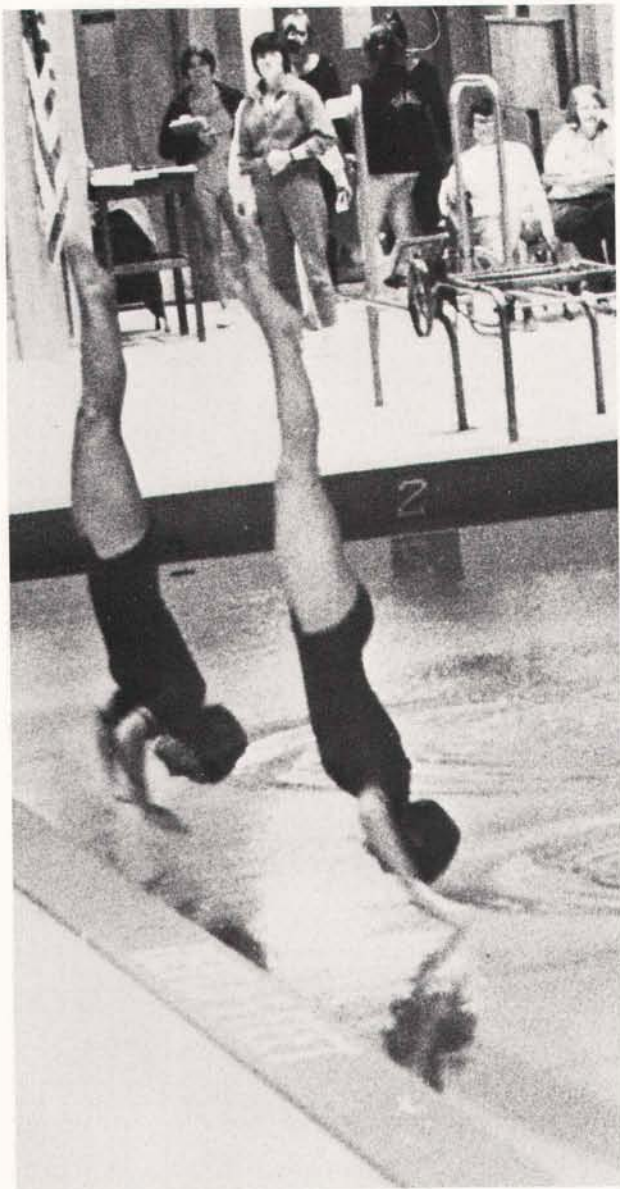
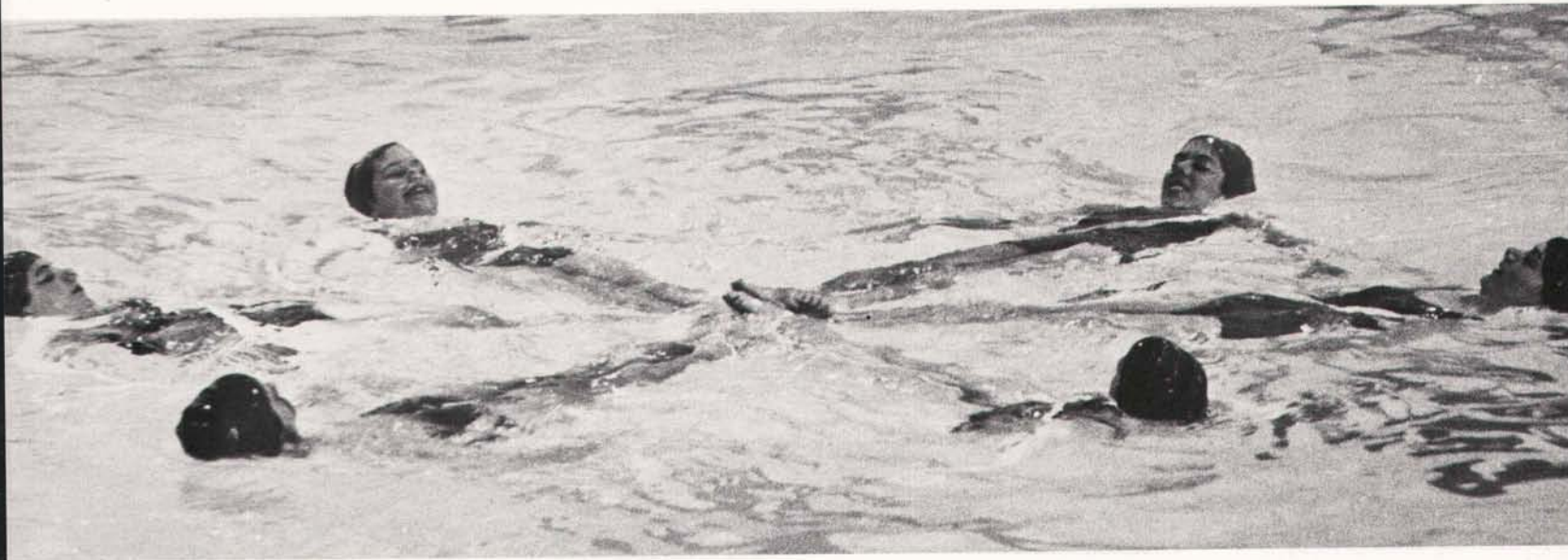


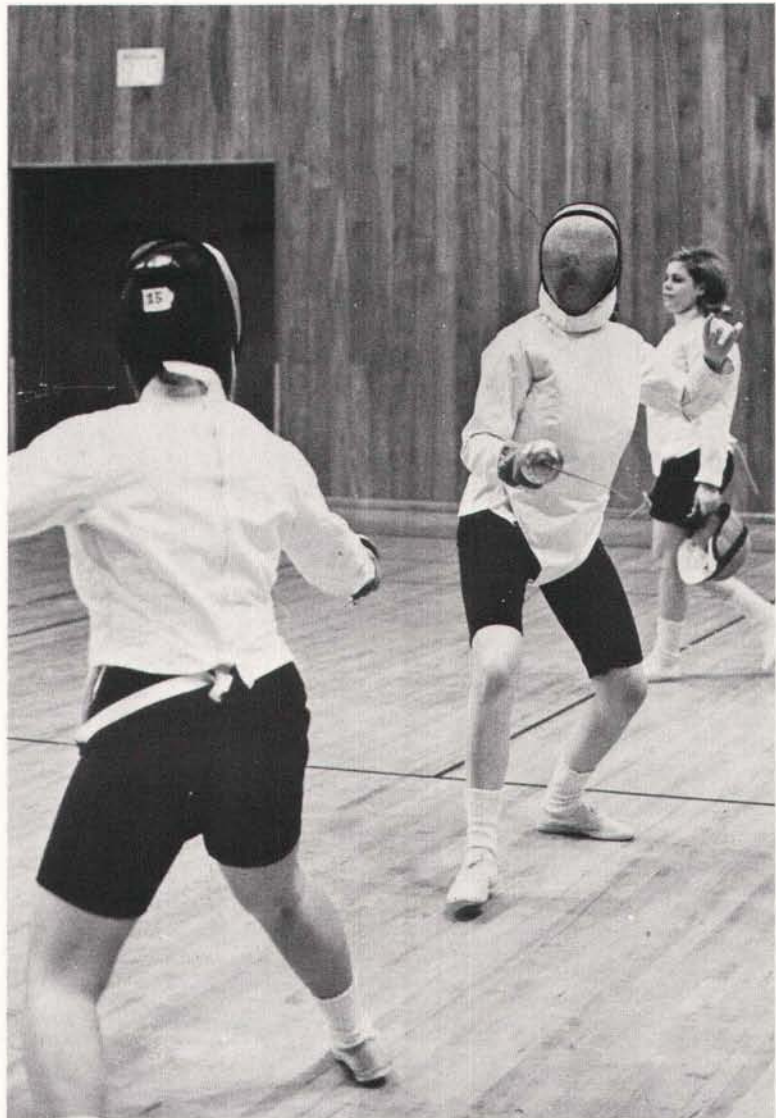
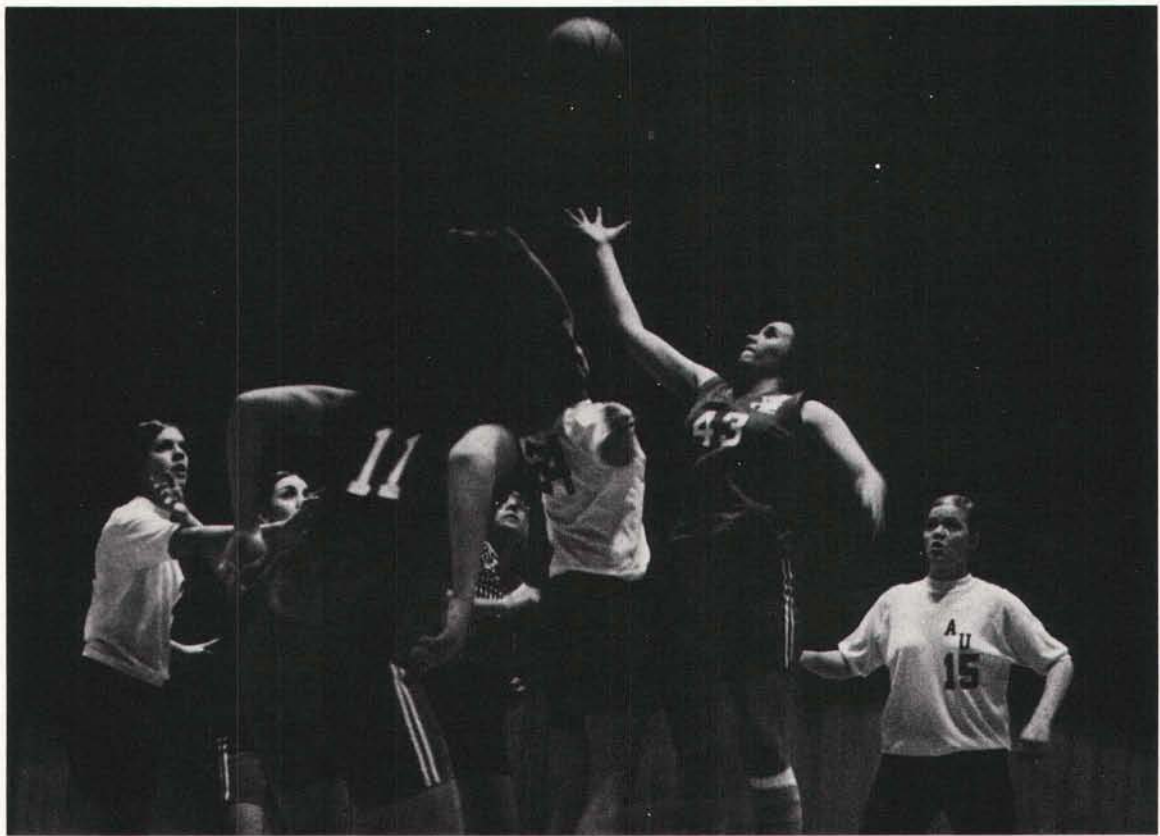






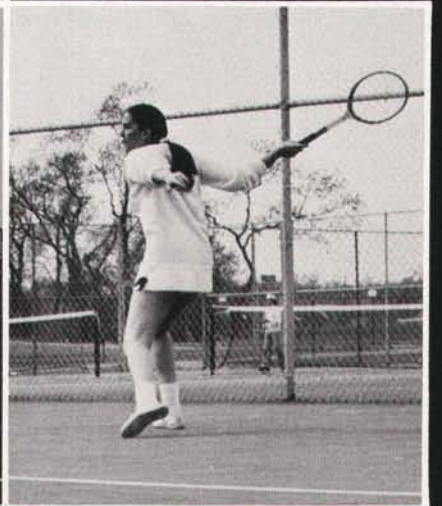
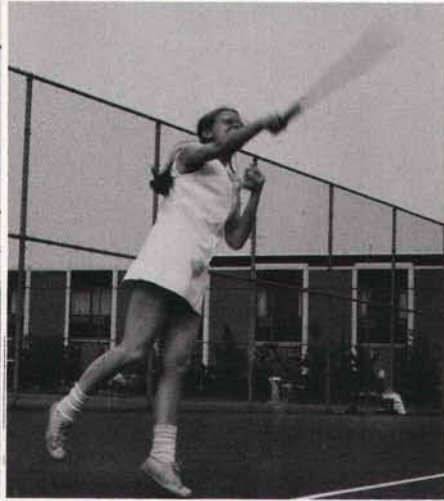
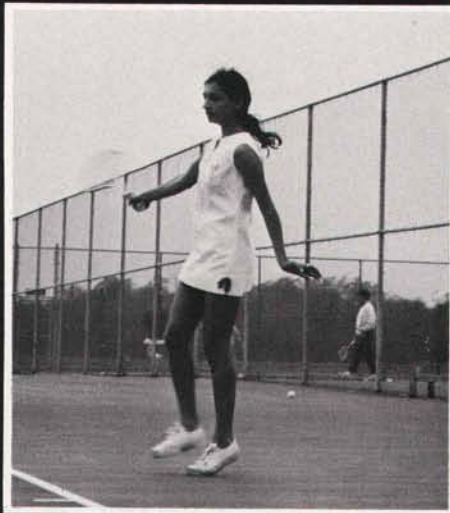


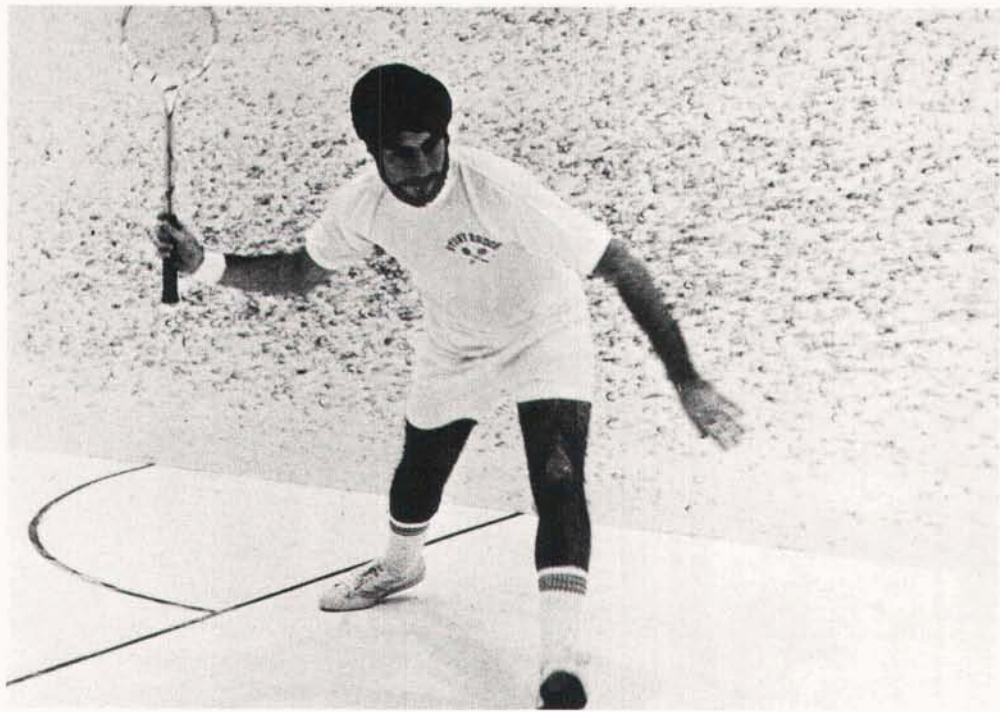

Individually, Chris Clark and Stuart Goldstein gave the Patriots their strongest one-two punch ever and both were instrumental in the important wins scored during the season.

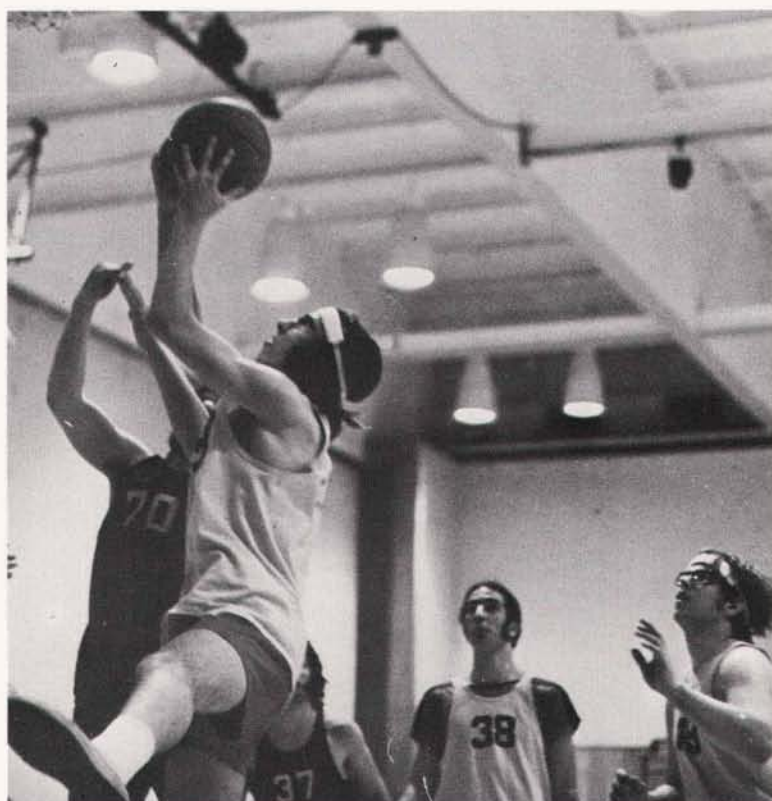
