Constitution of the Graduate Student Organization
ARTICLE I - Name
The name of the organization shall be the Graduate Student Organization of Stony Brook University, hereinafter referred to as the GSO.

## ARTICLE II - Purpose

The purpose of the GSO is to identify and protect the rights of graduate students, advance their interests, provide a forum for public debate and promote graduate student participation in University affairs. The GSO is committed to affirmative action/equal employment laws and to prohibiting discrimination on the basis of sex, race ethn icity, religion, national origin, age, sexual orientation, disability, marital status, or veteran status.

ARTICLE III - Membership
Membership in the GSO shall consist of all graduate students who are enrolled at Stony Brook University and paying student activity fees. Any member of the GSO that satisfies the criteria in Elections Bylaws is eligible to be an officer of the GSO, and may serve on any GSO committee. All members of the GSO are eligible to vote in officer elections, referenda, and other organization-wide ballots. All members of the GSO vote equally.

ARTICLE IV - Officers

The offices of the GSO shall be those of the President, Secretary and Treasurer.

## Section A: President

The President shall:

- act as a spokesperson for the GSO in the presentation of its positions and enunciation of its policies;
- supervise the execution of Senate-approved legi
- appoint and remove members of all GSO and Un committees, subject to confirmation by a majori vote of the Senate respectively, over which the of appointment; nominate and recommend the r candidates, subject to confirmation by a majorit thirds of the Senate respectively, for University which the GSO holds no power of appointment. of emergency appointment, the President shall n for members interested in specific committees, week prior to the official confirmation by the Sen
- chair meetings of the Executive Council;
- in conjunction with the current Executive Counc open search and recommend a candidate to the for the position of Graduate Student Advocate to for the position of Graduat academic year.
- hire and remove the GSO Control \& Disbursement (C\&D) Agent, subject to a two thirds vote of the Executive Council.
- Report at each Senate meeting a summary of her or his activities and such activities of the University Committees which may be of interest to GSO members;
- has the power to interpret this Constitution. In absence, this power devolves upon the Vice Pres or Treasurer, in that order.


## Section B: Vice President

The Vice President shall:

- assist the President in the execution of her or his duties
fulfill the responsibilities and duties delegated to her or him by the President;
- in the absence of the President, perform all duti concern vested in the President;
- shall organize training of the elected officers afte Elections:

## Section C: Secretary

The Secretary shall:

- record, publish, and report the minutes of Senat Council meetings
- assist the President with the dissemination of GS public;
- maintain and distribute a membership list of the Senate;
- chair the Election Committee;
- report at each Senate meeting a summary of he which may be of interest to GSO members.


## Section D: Treasurer

The Treasurer shall:

- chair the Budget Committee
be responsible for the management of all GSO revenues and expenditures, as detailed in the Budget Committee Bylaws;
- in conjunction with the Budget Committee, the Executive Council, prepare the organization's budget for the following academic year;
- provide an oral and written update on the state least once every semester;
- report at each Senate meeting a summary of he which may be of interest to GSO members.


## Section E: Election, Removal and Succession

- The election must reflect the informed consent of the constituency. All departments shall demonstrate informed consent through an organized departmental election.

## ARTICLE VI - Executive Council

The Executive Council is comprised of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Speaker of the Senate. The C\&D Agent shall participate as non-voting members.

Section A: The Executive Council shall:

- have general supervision of the affairs of the GSD between Senate meetings;
coordinate the activities of the GSO, its officers, representatives;
- recommend policies, programs and activities to bring resolutions before the Senate
- oversee the operation of the GSO office
- carry out the directives of the Senate

## Section D: University Committees

- Any GSO member can be appointed by the Presi confirmation by a majority vote of the Senate, t GSO on a University Committee over which the of appointment.
- Any GSO member (or members) can be nominated by the President, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the senate, as a candidate (or candidates) for a University committee over which the GSO holds no power of appointm
GSO representatives shall inform the Executive proceedings and actions of the University Comm they serve.
- Representatives shall be removed upon the reco the President and a majority vote of the Senate.


## ARTICLE VIII - Amendments and Referenda

Section A: Amendments to the GSO Constitution

- Amendments to the GSO Constitution may be proposed by any SO member. Proposed amendments require approval by at least $75 \%$ of the Senators in the GSO Senate in order Should the Senate fail to approve the proposed shall be put to a vote of the membership upon $p$ petition signed by 200 GSO members.
- A proposed amendment approved by petition sh during the membership-wide election for GSO of Senate convenes a special membership-wide ele of a proposed amendment requires a two-thirds membership.
- An amendment to the GSO Constitution shall no voted on at the same Senate meeting unless it i 10 days prior to the meeting via hard copy or el Senators (e.g. via the list-serve).


## Section B: Referenda

- Referenda may be proposed by any GSO membe referenda require a majority vote of the Senate to a membership-wide vote. Should the Senate proposed referendum, it shall be put to a vote o upon presentation of a petition signed by at leas members, with no more than 30\% of the petitio department or school
