Hi all,

Thanks to everyone for a productive meeting. If I have forgotten something, my apologies. Here's the run-down of what transpired -

We are having tabling in the SAC from 10am-2pm and in the Union from 2pm-5pm. We have gotten several outside groups to participate including LIGALY, Kim Schulze from UUFH and PFLAG. The decision was made to forgo the panel presentations this year due to lack of time to adequately publicize this. Lanna made flyers that have been distributed around campus. Linda and Lanna were both able to have announcements put in for both HSC side and West campus, respectively. Linda was able to contact Women's Studies and put the call out for people to participate in the event. Smita was able to the secure both the SAC and the Union for tabling locations. Kristen is making an exhibit in the Frank Melville Library from LGBT Special Collections. After our meeting, Lanna ordered 400 buttons, in the event we cannot get buttons donated, due to time constraints with Cafepress.

Specifics of what we are working on -

Lanna is making new flyers and putting in another campus announcement. If you have a specific logo that needs to be into the flyer, please send that to Lanna. Linda will be putting in another campus announcement for the HSC side. Smita is trying to secure a rain location for the SAC and also contacting on-campus groups such as the UCC and campus police. Sarah is contacting groups on campus to get various things donated such as food, t-shirts, and buttons and also contacting on-campus groups to participate. I am ordering some t-shirts, just in case we cannot get them donated, working on the OUTList, HRC and coordinating the outside groups. Kristen is still working on getting someone from the LI Pride Parade (Steve Henaghan) for a presentation. In the event we cannot get a speaker from LI Pride Parade, does anyone else have any ideas? If we do get a speaker, Pam will be working on that as well.

We are having a meeting Thursday at 2pm in the same location. (Frank Melville Library, administration, large conference room).

Sarah, I need to get in touch with the student group to see if they are going to participate in Coming Out Day ie - have a table.

Also, a general question which I neglected to ask - are the flyers being put out? Do we need to coordinate that to ensure that the word goes out?

And again, a big thanks to everyone for being involved in an event that has taken an enormous amount of work!
