## CRITICAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT

- 1. Faculty and staff should include a statement in course syllabi regarding the instructor's responsibility to report behavior that interrupts the learning process, the instructor's ability to perform his/her duties, or compromises the safety of other students. The statement is as follows ("The University at Stony Brook expects students to maintain standards of personal integrity that are in harmony with the educational goals of the institution; to observe national, state, and local laws and University regulations; and to respect the rights, privileges, and property of other people. Faculty is required to report disruptive behavior that interrupts faculty's ability to teach, the safety of the learning environment, and/or students' ability to learn to Judicial Affairs.")
- 4. Require all Chairs, Undergraduate Directors, and Graduate Directors to participate as a requirement in Behavior Risk Prevention and Reporting Training. The mechanism by which this training will occur will be communicated to the departments.
