2009 CAMPUS STATEMENT

Established in 1912 as the State Institute of Applied Agriculture, Farmingdale State College is the oldest public college on Long Island and one of the original state "Land-Grant" colleges of agriculture. Today, Farmingdale fulfills a distinct niche as the only public college of Applied Science and Technology on Long Island. The campus is unique within SUNY as the largest of the Colleges of Technology (in enrollment) and the only Technology College with a campus-based Incubator facility (Broad Hollow Bioscience Park).

The College's 386-acre campus is located on Route 110 and is bisected by the Nassau and Suffolk County boundary. The campus has buildings that reflect its history as well as the history of the State University of New York. Buildings such as Hicks and Cutler Halls, Ward Hall, Thompson Hall and several others reflect the traditional Georgian architecture of their time. Many of these historic buildings were closed years ago and are in dire need of renovation and repair. A second wave of construction occurred in the 1950s, followed by another wave in the late 1960s through the 1970s.

The past two decades has seen the campus capital program attempt to catch up with years of deferred maintenance in terms of roofs, site infrastructure, mechanical systems, and related items with significant progress. Now, as the college's enrollment continues to grow, the emphasis has shifted to the rehabilitation/modernization of academic spaces, improvements to student spaces (commuter spaces in particular), and the development of the landscaping of the 100-year-old campus. A new site landscaping project will focus on health and safety while upgrading walks, lighting, parking, roads and parking and providing a clear delineation between vehicular and pedestrian zones. This site project, the new Campus Center now in design, and the upcoming Facilities Master Plan will be transformative to the campus. A key element for the success of all of these projects, however, is the relocation of the Day Care Center now located in "temporary" structures at a prominent area of the campus. A new Day Care Center in a much more appropriate location is in the Campus Capital Plan but has not yet been authorized to proceed.

In addition to the above special efforts which highlight the 2008 Capital Program, the college continues to make great progress with Critical Maintenance items. Over the past year projects have included the construction of a new Soccer/Lacrosse/Track facility, and a new tennis complex funded from our athletic fee which is currently in-progress. Both, in addition to the already completed baseball stadium, provide much needed enhancement to our athletic program and our newly gained stature in the NCAA. In addition to these, several projects have progressed through standard Capital funding such as exterior improvements to landscaping and building entries, a two building restroom rehab, repairs on several slate roofs, and upgrades of the power plant and energy management system. The campus expects to increase the number of campus-administered projects in the future.


