2009 CAMPUS STATEMENT

Established in 1965 as a nontraditional campus, the College at Old Westbury has created a culturally diverse environment, offering 3,500 students 46 undergraduate majors, graduate degrees in Accounting and Taxation, 16 minors in liberal arts and professional fields. The College begins its MAT degrees in secondary education in Biology, Chemistry, Math, Social Studies and Spanish. The College's School of Education is NCATE accredited and the School of Business is progressing towards obtaining AACSB accreditation.

The College's 604 acre campus, located on Long Island, offers a quiet atmosphere dedicated to learning, while only 20 miles from the heart of New York City. The main campus has 52 major buildings, including a new Residence Hall complex and Student Union building. The campus also includes buildings from the Ambrose Clark Estate; one of which is occupied by Empire State College.

The College began construction of a new 142,000 S.F. LEED's silver certifiable academic building in March 2009. Design of the new university police building will be complete by July 2009 and bid this summer. The revamped student services complex began construction in January 2009 and Phase I will be completed in July of 2009. Phase II should be completed by November of 2009. The design of the replacement of the Campus Center exterior envelope and windows continues as well as the replacement of fuel tanks in the Service Group complex. The relocation of Student Health Services, Residential Life, EOP, the Business and Finance and Public Relations offices are in design.

A high priority for the College is the renovation of its infrastructure. The rewiring of the campus data networks is complete and installation of the IP security cameras system will be completed summer of 2009. Phase I of the Heat/Chill project and electrical switchgear are in construction phase. Design of the Phase II heat chill project will be complete this year. Air handler replacement for the Clark Athletic center has been designed and will be bid out this year.

The Campus is initiating design for paving the campus ring road, replacing air handlers in the Campus Center and rehabilitation of elevators this year.

Renovation projects completed in 2008-09 include the Campus Center floors and signage, two large lecture halls, fiber installed to upgrade fire alarms as well as renovation of Power Track Math Student lab.

Capital funded projects completed over the past several years include:

- Renovated locker rooms, showers and bathrooms,
- Rehabilitation of additional classrooms with computer/presentation equipment,
- Extension of wireless capability throughout the campus,
- Wiring for additional public computing workstations,
- Road and path signage as well as paving of entrances, aprons and ADA walkways,
- Renovation of television studio.
- Installation of a co-generation electrical energy system, and
- Replaced windows and roof for Empire State College.

All academic buildings, including the Academic Village, Campus Center and the Natural Science building, have student computer labs that are updated on a three year cycle.


