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Subject Campus Improvement Projects

IMPORTANT NOTICE

As part of overall Campus Improvement, the following projects will begin on the Monday after Commencement 5/20/02.

Removal of the Bridge over Center Drive.

The scope of this project is the complete removal of the bridge connecting the Stony Brook Union and the Melville Library. The project will begin on May 20th and has an anticipated completion date of July 1, 2002. The project will require the closing of Center Drive to through traffic. All loading docks will be accessible for local deliveries. Pedestrian traffic will be rerouted around the construction site. Please refer to the map on the Facilities Design and Construction and the Transportation and Parking Services web sites for the temporary pedestrian routes.

The summer bus schedule/stops has been revised to accommodate the rerouting of buses during this period. Stops at SB Union and in front of the Indoor Sports Complex will be inaccessible during the construction. New stops will be marked as "BRIDGE DEMO TEMPORARY BUS STOPS". These temporary stops will be at the following locations:

Across from the main entrance guard booth - S local (serves Admin)
At the intersection of North Loop Road and Infirmary road - N&S local (serves G&H quads)
At the intersection of Center Drive and Commissary Road - N&S local (serves Sports Complex)
At the intersection of North Loop and Center Drive - N local (serves Stony Brook Union)

Phase 2 Stadium Parking

In order to increase parking capacity the northern most section of the lot will be renovated. Included in this project are the parking areas south, west and north of the Infirmary. The parking lot construction will begin on May 20th and has an anticipated completion date of August 15, 2002.

Infirmary Road connection to Center Drive. As a means to improve traffic flow at our new Stadium, a connection between Infirmary Road and Center Drive will be established. Once completed, this connection will only be open for Stadium events. This work will begin on May 20th and has an anticipated completion date of August 15, 2002.
