Subject Elections - faculty and professional employees

Colleagues:

Online voting for the 2004 elections for the University Senate, the Arts and Science Senate, PEGBoard, Stony Brook representatives to the SUNY-wide Senate, and Faculty/Professional Employee seats on the FSA board is now open. Detailed instructions to access your ballot and vote via your Solar System account appear below. Balloting closes May 28 at 3 PM.

Voting:

After signing on to your solarsystem account, click on "For Employees" menu. A light yellow colored menu tab will then show up labeled "Voting". Click on that to see the ballot. Make your selections and then press the "Place Vote!" button to submit your vote.

Signing on to the SOLAR System:

The SOLAR System can be accessed from the University's main web site (http://www.sunysb.edu). The link to the SOLAR System site is half way down the page on the left. You will be presented with another web page. You should press the login button on the upper left hand corner of that web page and you will be directed to the SOLAR Signon Web page.

To access the SOLAR System, you will need your Stony Brook Id Number and a password. The Stony Brook Id number is the number of that

What's Needed to Sign On to the SOLAR System:

appears on the front of your Stony Brook University ID card, IT IS NOT YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. If you do not have an Id Card, we strongly suggest that you go to the campus ID card office and get one. Besides being the credential that Campus Security may require to confirm your authority to be on the campus, it is needed to borrow books from the campus libraries, is sometimes used for building access, and may be used to for various campus and banking services. You will need to bring one form of government issued photo id with you when you go to get your id card. Please see the campus card website for information on locations and hours. What to do if you don't know your password:

If you don't know your password and you have your Stony Brook Id Number, you can answer some simple questions on the signon page and your password will automatically be e-mailed to you. Follow the instructions for signing on to the SOLAR System (above) and click on the text line that says "To get your Stony Brook Id". If that doesn't work, call the Computer Accounts Office at 632-8011 during regular
