Subject: New York City Transit Strike

As you may know, there is a possibility of a transit disruption in New York City effective midnight, Sunday night. While we do not anticipate that many employees will be affected by a strike, we have received information from the Governor's Office of Employee Relations with regard to the possible impact to State employees. The following information applies to both State and Research Foundation employees.

If you are affected by a New York City transit strike, you are expected to make whatever arrangements may be necessary for timely arrival at work. Tardiness due to the strike may be excused without charge to leave credits where it is clearly established that such tardiness was unavoidable or necessitated by emergency conditions. Full day absences, even though unavoidable, may not be excused. They must be charged to annual leave, personal leave or other appropriate leave credits.
