Harper has published more than ten books of poetry, including *Songlines in Michaeltree: New and Collected Poems*; *Honorable Amendments*; *Healing Song for the Inner Ear*; *Images of Kin*, winner of the Melville-Cane Award from the Poetry Society of America; *Nightmare Begins Responsibility*; *History is Your Heartbeat*, winner of the Black Academy of Arts & Letters Award for poetry; and *Dear John, Dear Coltrane*, a National Book Award nominee. He was the first Poet Laureate of the State of Rhode Island (1988-1993) and has received many other honors, including a fellowship from the Guggenheim Foundation and a National Endowment for the Arts Creative Writing Award.
