Subject Re-elections for SUNY State-wide Senator Positions

Colleagues,

As reported at yesterday's meeting of the University Senate, well intended revitalization and reorganization decisions by governance bodies left the Professional Employees temporarily disenfranchised from this year's election for SUNY state-wide senators.

To rectify this oversight, the Univ. Senate Executive Committee has declared that the election for Stony Brook's current slate of openings for SUNY state-wide senators must be redone, beginning from the call for nominations.

Since it is late in the semester, the Univ. Senate Exec. is calling for a reasonably expedited re-election procedure.

With this e-mail, the Univ. Senate Exec. Committee therefore authorizes Laurie Theobalt, the Secretary of the Univ. Senate, to receive nominations for the two positions for SUNY state-wide senators from Stony Brook that are currently open. These two positions are reserved for nominations only of west campus full time faculty and west campus full time professional employees. All such nominations must be received within one week of the electronically stamped date/time of sending of this e-mail call.

Please send your nominations via e-mail to Laurie at ltheobalt@notes.cc.sunysb.edu Include the words "Nomination for SUNY state-wide senator" in the subject line of your e-mail.

Laurie will confirm receipt of nominations by replying back to the sender of the e-mail.

Upon deadline for receipt of nominations, the election process will be organized and further information on the voting procedure will be sent. All campus (east and west) full time faculty and professional employees will be eligible to vote for the slate of SUNY state-wide senators.
