Guy Consolmagno is curator of the Vatican Meteorite Collection, one of the largest meteorite collections in the world. Dr. Consolmagno's research explores the connections between meteorites and asteroids, and the origin and evolution of small bodies in the solar system. He is currently the Vice-Chair of the Division of Planetary Science of the American Astronomical Society.
