The Provost's Lecture Series is pleased to host a talk by Dr. Elaine Pagels.

Dr. Pagels is the Harrington Spear Paine Professor of Religion at Princeton University and a prolific author and renowned speaker. The *Gnostic Gospels* (1979), an analysis of early Christian manuscripts unearthed in Egypt, won the National Book Critics Circle Award and the National Book Award and was chosen by The Modern Library as one of the 100 best books of the 20th Century.

Pagels earned a B.A. and an M.A. from Stanford University and a Ph.D. from Harvard University. She is a recipient of a MacArthur fellowship. She taught at Barnard College prior to joining the faculty at Princeton. She has been profiled in *TIME*, *The Atlantic Monthly*, *Vogue*, *Mirabella*, *The New York Times Magazine* and *The New Yorker*.

Dr. Pagels will present her lecture entitled "The Cultural Impact of the Book of Revelation" on Wednesday, September 22, 4:30 PM in the Humanities Institute, Lecture Hall 1006.
