From organizers Anjelica Whitehorne and Merriah Eberts: "Though the competition is now over, we need to continue recycling. It's important to rinse and flatten your bottles and cans before you recycle them, and to ensure that there is no trash or contamination in your recycling bins. Glass should be rinsed, but not broken. When recycling mixed paper and corrugated cardboard, please make sure that it is clean and dry (pizza boxes can be

recycled as long as they are not greasy).

"Through the use of our 4R's Drop Center, located in the Duke Lecture Hall Lobby, we can divert even more from landfills and recycle through reuse. The Drop Center collects reusable office supplies for our R.O.S.E. (Reusable Office Supply Exchange) Program, inkjet and toner cartridges and cell phones, and clothing and shoes which are donated to Goodwill or reused through the Nike "Reuse-a-Shoe" Program. We have a Goodwill Drop Bin located at the Recycling Station outside of the Greenport Residence Hall, as well.
