## PRESCRIPTION DRUG CARD

There has been some questions among the members of the UUP as to where is "my" Prescription Card, and what if my druggist won't accept my NPA card where do I go or what should I do for reimbursement?

The answer to the first question of why I did not get my Prescription Card is that the enrollment card (if you are a new employee) may have been lost or misplaced while being sent to the Public Employees Benefit Fund. This can be solved by filling out another card, which can be obtained in the UUP Office on the 2nd level of the HSC, Room 167. If you have moved, call the PEBF Office, 800-522-7002 to give them your new address so you will get a card next year.

There are two (2) solutions to the "what if my druggist won't accept my NPA card"?

One, you might have your druggist call NPA (toll free at 800-526-7813) to inquire about joining the NPA panel of druggists.

Two, you pay for the prescription and submit a green NPA direct-reimbursement form to your druggist to fill out and then you forward it to NPA for reimbursement. (Forms may be obtained from the UUP office) CAUTION:: You will be paid an amount no greater than the amount paid to your druggist (if your druggist charges above usual, customary and reasonable charge (UCR) for the drug ingredient cost, you will only be reimbursed for the UCR amount minus the \$2 co-pay). These vouchers must be submitted within 45 days of the date of the prescription purchase in order for you to be reimbursed.

A list of druggists for the four counties is available and kept in the UUP Office, L2 - Room 167.


