The HSC Chapter has grown by approximately 200 members during President Hartnett's term of office. Membership now numbers 540 persons.


WHAT IS A FIELD REP?

Through its affiliation with New York State United Teachers (NYSUT), UUP receives the services of NYSUT staff members. Each campus chapter of UUP is assigned a specific field representative to act as a resource person for the chapter and its leadership.

Many of you know the HSC Chapter field rep, Richard Baron. Mr. Baron is also assigned to UUP chapters in Farmingdale, Old Westbury and on the main campus here at Stony Brook. He provides services and gives advice to the elected chapter leadership at each of his four campuses.

Here at the HSC, Mr. Baron has been helpful in developing our department representative structure. For example, this past March Mavis Stephenson and Sheldon Scher organized a departmental representatives workshop to be given by Mr. Baron and his colleagues. Mr. Baron also has been instrumental in recruiting new members and has been a valuable asset in preparing and advocating grievances with the appropriate grievance chairs on behalf of our members.

In the past there has been some confusion over the field rep's role in determining and implementing policy. The policy making process is not one of the functions of the field rep. This remains the providence of the chapter president and executive board under the guidance and advice of the central UUP President and his Executive Board. All questions that deal with policy or interpretation of policy should be directed to the chapter leadership for review and implementation.
