



# Semester by the Sea

## Marine Sciences



Spend the fall semester immersed in marine studies while in residence at the Stony Brook Southampton campus



Investigate the bays, estuaries, salt marshes, rocky intertidal, beaches, tidal flats, and open ocean of eastern Long Island, and learn about environmental issues related to these habitats. Students also explore the contemporary and historic maritime traditions of the region via small classes and focused field trips to sites that have shaped these traditions.



Students enroll in 3 required courses  
**Long Island Marine Habitats**  
**Maritime Traditions of New England**  
**Coastal Culture Experience**



Students also select two electives  
**Marine Mammals**  
**Physical Oceanography**  
**Experimental Marine Biology**  
**Ichthyology**  
**Ocean Chemistry**

Any undergraduate may enroll, but the program is best suited for U3/U4 science majors as several of the electives have prerequisites.

Non-marine science students can earn a minor in marine science by also taking MAR 104 the following semester.
