Subject: 2012 Turner Summer Research Grant Program (TSRG)

I am pleased to announce that we will once again review applications from Turner Fellows for summer 2012 research grant funding. The Turner Summer Research Grant funding is a competitive program and the granting of funds is based on both academic rigor and the involved research being tied to a specific, detailed project that is anticipated to serve as part of your dissertation/thesis/final research project. Research *can* be exploratory in nature but must be connected to your current plans for thesis and dissertation work. Turner Summer Research Grant funding is strictly supplementary and is not intended as a permanent funding source of the Turner Fellowship. Funding can be used to cover **research-related expenses** incurred during the months of May, June, July and August, and, For the first time this year, Turner will also consider summer stipend funding requests if justification is provided and your total annual stipend does not exceed \$30K.

There are some important guidelines that must be followed as you prepare your application:

- 1. In order to be considered, an application for summer funding is required in addition to a detailed narrative. Additionally, a letter of support from your advisor (or Graduate Program Director if you do not yet have an advisor) is required.
- 2. Students requesting summer research support to cover the cost of language training may do so only once throughout the duration of their graduate studies.
- 3. All paperwork for reimbursement will be required to be submitted to the Turner Fellowship office within two weeks of the end date listed on your application. Failure to supply the Turner Fellowship office with a complete set of documents by this time will result in a loss of reimbursement of summer funds. Due to the fiscal circumstances surrounding the budget, no exceptions can be made. And of course, as always, only items deemed "allowable" by the state budget will be reimbursed, so please ensure that you investigate and understand the policies surrounding this and adhere to this stipulation before incurring any costs you expect to be reimbursed for.

The following chart indicates the hierarchy of supplying funds. Once again, there may be exceptions made to these eligibility positions depending upon fund available and the strength of an application.

FUNDING ELIGIBILITY ACCORDING TO YEARS ON FELLOWSHIP AS OF THE 2011-2012 ACADEMIC YEAR

G5	Eligible	Highest Priority: Fellows who are expected to complete their doctoral dissertation this year or during the 2012-2013 academic year.
G1-G4	Eligible	Depending on funds availability.

An application for funds does not guarantee that you will receive the entire amount that you have requested. **Requests cannot exceed \$3,000**, and if approved you will only be reimbursed up to the amount awarded in your award letter. A total of 10-12 awards are expected to be granted through a competitive review process. Please be detailed and thorough in your application in order to present yourself as competitively as possible.

Please note that your acceptance of summer support will confirm your participation as a presenter in one of our future Center for Inclusive Education Research Cafés for which you will be asked to prepare a 10-15 minute presentation about your work and facilitate a question and answer session with other Turner and AGEP students.

Please use the attached application to submit your request for summer funding. Be accurate and exact in your application, as changes to an application will only be considered after all award determinations have been made. The TSRG deadline is Friday, April 4, 2012.
