

## **CEAS POLICY ON RESCINDING SCHOLARSHIPS**

Students are informed of the scholarship criteria when they receive their award letters. Any student who no longer meets the requirements of the scholarship (e.g. if a student changes major, graduates, moves on to a graduate program or fails to maintain the required g.p.a.) will have his/her scholarship rescinded.

If a student makes a significant improvement in his/her grades and cumulative g.p.a. he/she may petition to the Undergraduate Student Office to have his/her scholarship reinstated. Reinstatement of a scholarship is not guaranteed and is contingent upon available funding.

A student's scholarship will also be rescinded if a notation of academic dishonesty appears on the student transcript. In such a case, the student will be notified by letter and there will be no opportunity for restoration of the scholarship.
