Scott Higham is a Pulitzer Prize winning reporter at the Washington Post. The 2002 Pulitzer was awarded for an investigation into the deaths of children who were supposed to be under the supervision of the D.C. child protection system. The series also won the 2002 Robert F. Kennedy grand prize for reporting on the disadvantaged. Higham was a finalist for the 2005 Pulitzer for a series on the treatment of detainees held at Abu Ghraib prison in Iraq. Before joining the Washington Post, Higham was a reporter at The Baltimore Sun, The Miami Herald and The Allentown Morning Call.

Higham is a graduate of Stony Brook University where he was executive editor of

The Stony Brook Press. He holds a master's degree from Columbia University's Graduate School of Journalism.
