<b>Pupils</b>	Normal	Normal	Fixed, mid dilated	Irregular, small
<b>Cornea</b>	Clear, no stain	Abnormal	Hazy	Keratic precipitates Severe, late - hazy
<b>Anterior Chamber</b>	Normal	Normal	Shallow	Normal
<b>Iris</b>	Normal	Normal	Normal	Synechiae
<b>Tonometry</b>	Normal	Normal	High	High, normal or low

Other Minor causes of Red Eye
