Figure 1. Smoking History - 131 newly diagnosed lung cancer patients at Stony Brook Hospital in 2001




Figure 2. Gender distribution for lung cancer patients at Stony Brook Hospital in 2001 compared to National Cancer Data Base 1994-1998 benchmark report.




Figure 3. Age at diagnosis of lung cancer at Stony Brook Hospital in 2001 compared to National Cancer Database 1994-1998 benchmark report.




Figure 4. Lung cancer histology in 2001 at Stony Brook Hospital




Figure 5. Diagnostic procedures in lung cancer performed at Stony Brook Hospital in 2001




Figure 8. Lung Cancer AJCC TNM stage at diagnosis in 131 newly diagnosed cases at Stony Brook in 2001 compared to NCDB 1994-1998 benchmark report.




Figure 10. Radiation therapy volume treated in patients with primary lung cancer at Stony Brook University Hospital in 2001




Figure 11. Treatment of lung cancer in 2001 for 131 newly diagnosed cases at Stony Brook Hospital
