To help you provide the best care to your patients, Stony Brook University Medical Center offers physicians access to their patients' electronic medical records.

Community physicians and their designated employees can apply for access simply by filling out an application and signing a confidentiality agreement.

Through Stony Brook's electronic medical record system, the following programs are available:



VPN The Virtual Private Network is a web-based program that enables users to log on securely to the Stony Brook University Medical Center Electronic Medical Record, and is used to access the internal network remotely.



Eclipsys® This application enables the user to view documented scanned patient information (i.e., progress notes, consults, and other documentation) and to sign reports.



PACS The picture archiving and communications system enables users to view radiology images and reports.



The Cerner PowerChart®

This Electronic Medical Record system is used for viewing clinical data, completing orders, and optimizing clinical documentation.
