Important Note: This application is not intended for matriculated Stony Brook students. Stony Brook students seeking to enroll in this program should contact Kurt Bretsch (Kurt.Bretsch@stonybrook.edu) or Christopher Goble (Christopher.Goble@stonybrook.edu).

This application is exclusively for use by the student seeking to enroll in Stony Brook University's Semester by the Sea: Marine Sciences at Stony Brook Southampton for the Fall 2013 semester as a non-matriculating undergraduate. A non-matriculated undergraduate is a student who is taking undergraduate courses at Stony Brook, but not pursuing a Stony Brook degree.

The following are required to be considered for admission to Stony Brook University's Semester by the Sea Marine Sciences program at Stony Brook Southampton for the Fall 2013:

- ★ A completed Semester by the Sea: Marine Sciences Fall 2013 Application.
- ★ Satisfactory completion of two college-level courses in the fundamentals of biology by the start of the Fall 2013 semester.
- ★ Official copies of all college transcripts (and high school transcripts and SAT/ACT scores for applicants with fewer than 24 college credits).
- ★ Applicants whose native language is not English must provide proof of English proficiency with a minimum composite score of 213 (computer-based) or 550 (paper-based) on the TOEFL exam, a minimum SAT Critical Reading score of 430, a minimum score of 80 on the IB TOEFL, or a score of 6.5 or higher on the IELTS. Satisfactory completion of Stony Brook's Intensive English Center program at the advanced level with a grade of B or better will be accepted in place of a TOEFL score. Because enrollment in this program is limited, applicants are strongly advised to submit all application materials as soon as possible.
