FROM THE STONY BROOK FOUNDATION CHAIRMAN



Despite the economy, our donors gave more than \$38.8 million to the Foundation by Council for Aid to Education (CAE) standards last year and more than \$45 million to the University overall. Here are a few 2010-2011 highlights of the tremendous impact donors to the Stony Brook Foundation are having on the University: This fiscal year saw the highly anticipated opening of the Simons Center for Geometry and Physics building in November as well as the key appointment of Ken A. Stony Brook Gala raised \$2.34 million to benefit both Stony Brook Children's and scholarships for Stony Brook's extraordinary students. And these are just a few of the ways in which our Foundation's donors continue to enhance Stony Brook.



On behalf of the Stony Brook Foundation Board, I thank you again for your generosity and dedication to Stony Brook.



Understanding the Environment for Today and Tomorrow

Stewardship of the environment is increasingly necessary for the well-being of our natural world, and understanding the science that will make these efforts successful is crucial. From School of Marine and Atmospheric Sciences (SoMAS) studies on how apex predators maintain the health of our marine ecosystems, to research about the loss of Long Island's shellfish and how best to restore them, to the new Advanced Energy Research and Technology Center and its opportunities for green start-up companies, to five majors in the innovative Sustainability Studies Program, Stony Brook is pursuing advanced research to help us respond to today's pressing environmental issues and foster the growth of bright, young minds to address tomorrow's issues. Generous gifts such as those from the Thye family for the Institute for Ocean Conservation Science and from the Laurie Landau Foundation for the Shinnecock Bay Restoration Project—both SoMAS programs—significantly increase our capabilities to tackle environmental issues from an informed perspective.

Collectively, in the past fiscal year environmentally minded donors like these gave more than \$1.4 million to wide-ranging initiatives across the University.

Community Support for Stony Brook Long Island Children's Hospital Grows

Stony Brook Long Island Children's Hospital (Stony Brook Children's) enjoyed a growth spurt as it marked its first year as Suffolk County's only children's hospital. The Pediatric Emergency Department saw substantial growth in patient volume over the prior year and its child-friendly waiting room was named "Stony Brook Hospital Auxiliary Waiting Room" in recognition of the Auxiliary's generous gift. Stony Brook Children's also unveiled the first-ever all-private-room Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in New York. Within the new NICU, the Pelletier and DeCristofaro families have been recognized for their support of Stony Brook Children's through the naming of the unit's conference room.

News of Stony Brook Children's helped recruit additional board-certified pediatric specialists from around the country, and there was a \$1 million commitment from an anonymous donor and a related pledge to match all donations to Stony Brook Children's up to \$9 million. This transformative gift is dedicated to designing child- and family-centered facilities along with programs that promote healing and minimize the trauma of hospital stays.

A Campus Without Borders

Stony Brook provides students with a learning experience far beyond the pages of a book, the edges of a screen, the boundaries of its campus, or even the borders of our nation. With globalization ever more important, Stony Brook offers students Study Abroad and Exchange Programs with destinations from Seoul to Sussex, as well as a minor in International Studies. Shortly after the fiscal year ended, two years of progress culminated in an announcement by SUNY Chancellor Nancy L. Zimpher and Stony Brook President Samuel L. Stanley Jr., M.D., that SUNY Korea, an institution funded by Korea and with joint faculty from Stony Brook and Korea, has been established and will be offering graduate degrees in engineering and in technology and society. Also, each year the University welcomes students from more than 100 countries (and nearly all 50 states), so students can learn from and appreciate diverse perspectives while giving one another the gift of their own experiences.

Through the Center for Italian Studies, which celebrated its 25th anniversary this year; the Center for India Studies; the Japan Center; the Latin American and Caribbean Studies Center; the Korean Studies Center; and the programming and exhibitions at the

Charles B. Wang Center, the local community supports and participates in a learning experience that celebrates both the uniqueness of each country/region and our ever-changing ties to them. Last year, more than \$291,000 was raised to benefit the Centers that help to link the University with the greater community and our institution with the rest of the world.

Excellence and Engagement in Dental Medicine

Stony Brook's School of Dental Medicine combines exceptional programs with a concerted commitment to the greater community. The School was ranked 14th in 2010 among NIH/NIDCR-funded dental schools, has helped to produce 58 patents and 26 patents-pending for oral health care products and anti-inflammatory drugs, and currently leads the country in clinical trials on periodontal disease and diabetes and cardiovascular disease. Skilled candidates and established faculty alike change patients' lives and their own when they participate in dynamic outreach programs to help the underserved in the southern Appalachians, the South Dakota Pine Ridge Reservation, Chile, Madagascar, and Kenya, as well as in our local community.

We are grateful to all of our 2010-2011 School of Dental Medicine donors, including Dentsply Tulsa Dental Specialties

and Nobel Biocare USA for major commitments; Straumann for its continuing support; the late Margot Ammann Durrer, M.D., for her bequest to the Dr. Gustav Durrer Travel Award and other areas; and Pamela J. Combs, D.D.S. '89 and her husband John Primavera for establishing an endowment to recognize leadership and community service among graduating candidates.

Strengthening New Generations of Athletes, Leaders, and Team Players

Stony Brook scholar-athletes compete at a high level while learning lessons in leadership, teamwork, dedication, and sportsmanship that they can carry into the classroom and the working world. Last year, Stony Brook's Seawolves showed their dedication to success through regular-season or conference championships in women's cross country, baseball, men's lacrosse, and football, with men's basketball reaching the America East Championship for the first time ever. In all, we celebrated a record six championships, garnered nine All-American honors, and had more than 200 honor-roll student-athletes.

To help these student-athletes, Glenn Dubin '78 and his wife Eva made the largest private gift to athletics in the history of SUNY for The Dubin Family Athletic Performance Center, a state-of-

the-art strength and conditioning facility. "Glenn Dubin often speaks of the significant role that athletics played in his personal, educational, and professional development," said President Stanley when the gift was announced. "The Dubin Family Athletic Performance Center will reflect that sentiment and provide a world-class venue to support and train Stony Brook student-athletes for success in both athletic competition and in life."



Giving to Scholarships at Stony Brook

Giving to Stony Brook—a university recognized as one of the world's finest for research and discovery, interdisciplinary education, and cultural offerings—means investing in new learning opportunities for the nation's most talented students. Scholarships are the cornerstone for closing the financial gap and helping deserving students in need realize their full potential and advance their professions. Despite challenging times, Stony Brook awarded more than \$3.5 million in scholarship support in 2010-2011, and the Stars of Stony Brook Gala has generated more than \$21 million for scholarships over the past 12 years.
