

## What is RSP?

The Residential Safety Program is a student managed organization that promotes safety on campus. The RSP staff consists of professional and resident students, in undergraduate, graduate and Ph.D. programs. The RSP Team consists of 300 dedicated individuals who are concerned and understand the need to have an established safety program for our community. RSP provides a Walk Service for students who do not want to walk alone on campus. RSP patrols outside and inside campus residences, reporting and assisting in problems that may arise. In addition, RSP provides desk monitor service in buildings, to check in students and their guests.

### Special Events

RSP provides crowd control for the following events: Commencement, Roth Regatta, Sprint Night, International Students Festival, and traffic patrol for the opening and closing of the residential halls.

### Personal Safety Tips

- Do not walk alone
- Keep your doors locked at all times
- Do not give your keys or ID card to others
- Do not let others in the exterior doors
- Do not prop doors open
- Use Blue Light phones
- Report all vandalism
- Report strangers in residence halls
- When in doubt, call University Police at 333

## Leadership Opportunities

RSP is actively recruiting for the following positions:

### Shift Leader

- Maintain and oversee nightly operations.
- Interact frequently with Desk and Field Unit Monitors and RAs.
- Serve as the nightly dispatcher.
- Attend biweekly scheduling meetings.
- Must have a year of Desk Monitor and Field Unit Experience.
- Pay is experience-based.

### Field Unit Monitors

- Maintain the security and safety of each building:  
Carefully securing each door.  
Preventing unauthorized persons from entering buildings.
- Check for broken windows and record the proper information.
- Check for functioning phones outside residential halls.
- Patrol quad parking lots.
- Check on the safety of Desk Monitors.
- Escorting any walks upon request.
- Pay is experience-based.

### Desk Monitor

- Check student IDs to make sure that they live in the building.
- Assist RAs in the case of emergencies (as needed).
- Night hours are 11:00 pm to 3:00 am.
- Expect to work on some weekends.
- Pay is experience-based.
