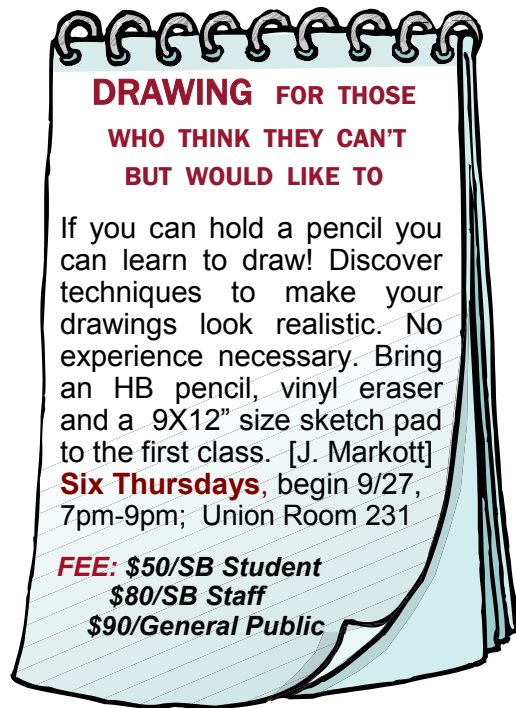

REGISTER FOR CLASS
