Provides funding aid to dependents of UUP bargaining unit members earning at least 12 undergraduate credits per semester at a SUNY school (not community college) with minimum of 2.0 GPA. award is for \$500 per semester up to a maximum of 8 semesters. Apply within 60 days after conclusion of a semester.
