Here's to more cooperation and camaraderie among us all in the upcoming year. We surely got off to a good start at the event planned by our social events committee on Jan. 7th.



To: All UUP represented employees

In accordance with the Agreement between the State of New York and United University Professions, full-time employees who were active on the payroll on December 31, 2003 are eligible to receive a location pay stipend for \$1,200.00. Payment will be included in the paycheck dated January 14, 2004.

Employees who were on an authorized leave with partial pay on December 31, 2003 will receive the Location Pay Stipend on a pro-rated basis consistent with their part-time salary rate.

Employees on a leave without pay on December 31, 2003 are not eligible for the Location Pay Stipend.
