## **ATTENTION TRAVELERS:**

News for those of you who rent a car for business transportation - i.e. travel from airport to lodging and conference location. When booking with Enterprise, the Stony Brook corporate code JN0645 must be given to receive contract rates. (Austin Travel in our library should porbably know this.)

Also, **insurance is no longer automatically included in the rental rates**. It is recommended that travelers purchase the damage waiver protection (<u>CDW or LDW insurance is the only type that will be reimbursed</u>) so as not to be held responsible for damages to the rental vehicle.
