FORUM ON SECURITY:

About twenty staff attended the forum on security which included a PowerPoint and exchange of ideas. One of the slides gave suggestions on how to deal with a library emergency situation such as behavioral episodes or patron/faculty/staff harassment. Further information was presented on the means to interact in a situation - one way (for minor instance) is to correct the person where others can hear and another way is to privately confront the person. If the person is not cooperating then the slide BELOW gave some ideas. Towards the end of the presentation, information was provided on notification + response to campus-wide emergencies.
