## PROPOSAL FOR APARTMENTS ON BROOKHAVEN LAB PROPERTY:

The Library has been asked to post the following information. <u>Any interested faculty or staff should contact Germaine</u>...... the Provost's Office would like to obtain a general assessment of the level of interest in this proposal.

Brookhaven National Lab has received DOE approval for sending a project to build apartments on their land out to bid. .... Performance Specifications require that units be provided with the latest design concepts in order to create pleasant interiors, with up-to-date appliances, similar or comparable to housing complexes being created in the towns and villages surrounding BNL. We are also requiring a variety of exterior treatments, setbacks, and roof lines, so as to create an interesting and pleasant series of connected residential apartments. Aesthetic enhancements such as common areas, courtyards, play areas and pedestrian walkways will also be included in the project

BNL is currently charging \$1,075/month for a single bedroom unit, \$1,265/month for a two bedroom unit, \$1,495/month for a three bedroom unit, and \$1,625/month for a four bedroom unit. We can anticipate that the new units will be somewhat higher.
