## **INSTRUCTION ON USE OF ACCRUALS DURING THE POWER OUTAGE:**

Since the electrical blackout on Thursday, August 14 and Friday, August 15 was an extraordinary event, the university administration has directed us, subject to approval by Albany, as follows:

Non Essential Employees who were scheduled to work but could not come in for power-related reasons, or were directed to stay home, or were at work for only part of the day, should not charge accruals for August 15. All time sheets should reflect the time not worked on August 15, but there is no need to charge your accruals. You must indicate that the time not worked was due to the power outage.

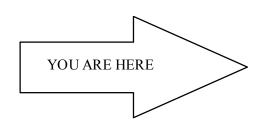
Those employees who reported to work on August 15 should report their hours to their supervisors.

Those employees who had prior approval for vacation, sick, personal, holiday or compensatory time on Friday August 15, 2003, <u>must</u> charge their accruals appropriately.

Those employees for whom August 15 was a scheduled pass day are not affected.
