HABITAT HOUSE 2007:

The 2007 house, a 2-story structure, will be built in Gordon Heights for Lorraine Hayes and her children. On Friday, September 14, and Saturday, September 15, 2007 we expect to complete the first floor framing, wallraise, sheathing and roof trusses.

During the following week, between Sept 20-22, we expect to raise the walls of the second story, as well as complete the second story hurricane strapping and sheathing.

Volunteers are needed for September 14 and 15, 20 or 21, 2007; we currently have a full group committed to September 22.
