A MESSAGE FROM THE SERIALS ACQUISITIONS & CONTROL DEPARTMENT:

Due to our inability to pay invoices or create new records in NOTIS during the month of March, we have a backlog of more than a month in setting up of new titles, title changes, and invoice payments. 
SEARCH HELP NEEDED:
