NEWS ABOUT THE MUSIC LIBRARY:

(Background) Stony Brook was invited to contribute a page to the national Website of The Science Coalition. Among the recent accomplishments at Stony Brook listed on the Web site is the announcement that the Emerson Quartet, one of the world's foremost chamber ensembles, will join the Stony Brook faculty as Quartet-in-Residence. The quartet mentioned Stony Brook's fine Music Library as one of the reasons for coming to Stony Brook.
