2) Tribute to a fallen hero (From David Weiner)

Captain Thomas C. Moody, long-time Stony Brook resident and NYC Firefighter, was killed in the line of duty on 9/11/01. As a tribute to Tom and his family, there is an effort underway to create a memorial in his honor, at Oxhead Road Park, which will include a large landscaped rock with a sign welcoming people to "The Home of the Thomas C. Moody Memorial Ballfield." Funds are needed to help pay for a plaque, the sign and landscaping (\$7,000). Any remaining funds will be presented to Tom's FDNY Hazardous Materials Unit (every member of Tom's squad died that day).

Tom was also a softball teammate of mine for 14 years and he is dearly missed. If you would like to offer a contribution for Tom's memorial, it would be greatly appreciated.

Information has been included in the Campus Announcements for this week. Briefly, it states that:
