Dear Members of the University Senate Library Committee,

I have just been contacted by Andrew White, the library director, who has informed me that he has arranged to have another set of consultants arrive very soon to give him advice on Monday, May 17. He has asked me to see if at least some of us could attend a meeting with the consultants.
