## **Clarification of Powers Act**

## A Bill

The purpose of this legislation is to repeal the "Campus Service Act," and to assert that the role of Senators and Executive Council officers, excepting the Vice President of Communications, is not to promote the Undergraduate Student Government but to fulfill our prescribed constitutional duties and responsibilities.

3	<b>SECTION 1.</b>	SHORT TITLE	
4	This act may be cited as the "Clarification of Powers Act"		
5			
6	<b>SECTION 2.</b>	FINDINGS; PURPOSE	
7		(1) <b>FINDINGS.</b> The Senate finds that—	
8		(a) the act heretofore known as the "Campus Service Act," by	
9		requiring Senators to disseminate information to classes via a	
10		presentation to be given twice a month, compelled Senators to	
11		carry out campus services above and beyond their	
12		constitutional duty as legislators; and	
13		(b) the Constitution of the Undergraduate Student Government	
14		clearly gives the duty of "communications or dissemination of	
15		information within the Undergraduate Student	
16		Government[including] dissemination of information to the	
17		members of the Undergraduate Student Government and/or its	
18		recognized groups" to the Vice President of Communications	
19		and Public Relations.	
20		(2) <b>PURPOSES.</b> The purpose of this act is to—	
21		(a) restore the constitutional responsibilities given to the separate	
22		branches of the Undergraduate Student Government; and	
23		(b) clearly define the function of the Vice President of	
24		Communications and Public Relations as the arm of the	

25		Undergraduate Student Government responsible for official	
26		acts of "communications or disseminations of information" to	
27		members of the Undergraduate Student Government.

29	SECTION 3.	REPEAL OF THE CAMPUS SERVICES ACT;	
30	CLARIFICATION OF POWERS		
31	(a) The "Campus Service Act" is hereby repealed.		
32	(b) It is the Constitutional and legal responsibility of the Vice President of		
33	Communications and Public Relations to promote the Undergraduate Student		
34	Government.

36	<b>SECTION 4.</b>	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE &amp; AUTHORIZATION</b>	
37	(a) The prov	isions of this act shall be law, having full force and binding; shall	
38	take effect retroactively to the start of the Fall 2006 Semester; and no officer		
39	shall be punished for failure to fulfill the requirements of the Campus Service		
40	Act.		
41	(b) The Exec	cutive Council shall have the authority to enforce this act, including	
42	the adopt	ion and execution of policies and procedures made pursuant to it.
