COMMITTEE ON TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENT

Whereas, the current Chief Information Officer of the University has resigned;

Whereas, the status of Wi-Fi in the residence halls is intermittent at best;

Whereas, our phone bill is too expensive;

Whereas, too many IT departments exist and this creates confusion and overlap; and

Whereas, there is an apparent lack of direction within the Department of Information Technology.

Be it resolved by the Undergraduate Student Government assembled in the Senate -

1. There shall be established, a committee to study the current direction of technology on the West Campus of Stony Brook University (herein referred to as the committee);
2. The committee's membership shall consist of both internal and external persons to the USG. The members of the committee shall elect a Chairman and Vice-Chairman from its own membership;
3. The Executive Vice-President and President Pro Tempore of the Senate (herein referred to as the PPT) shall appoint members to the committee without regard to political affiliation and solely on the basis of fitness to perform the duties of the position; and
4. The committee shall submit a final report of its findings to the Senate of the Undergraduate Student Government prior to or on the first of April two thousand and eleven.
