

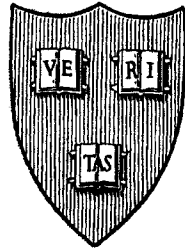

EDITORIAL NOTE.

THE Harvard Semitic Series consists of occasional volumes in the field of Semitic exploration, philology, literature, history, and religion.

Volumes I and II will give the results of the explorations carried on at Samaria in the years 1908—1910.

Volume III, Sumerian Tablets in the Harvard Semitic Museum, Part I, appeared in 1912. The present volume forms Part II of the Sumerian Tablets. The tablets here published are from the reigns of Dungi, Bur-Sin, and Gimil-Sin of the Dynasty of Ur. They were acquired by purchase from dealers in New York between 1895 and 1904, those corresponding to Museum numbers 1313—1346 (see below, pp. 18—22) in 1895, those to Museum numbers 1379—1868 in 1899, those to Museum numbers 3575—3584 in 1903, and those to Museum numbers 3624—3717 in 1904.

ABOUT forty-five of the tablets published in this volume were copied by me in 1909—1910, while holding the fellowship of the Baltimore Association for the Promotion of the University Education of Women. Friends of Oriental study in Cleveland, Ohio, made it possible for the work to be resumed in 1911—1912. This work was completed while assisting in the Harvard Semitic Museum in 1912—1913.

The vignette on the title page is a reproduction of seal impressions on tablet number 1441, dated in the reign of Dungi, belonging to the Harvard Semitic Museum.

To Professor George A. Barton I am indebted for stimulating suggestions in all of my work, and to Professor Albert T. Clay for generous advice and criticism. My heartiest thanks are due to Professor David Gordon Lyon, curator of the Harvard Semitic Museum, and to the other members of the editorial committee.

SYNOPSIS OF THE CONTENTS OF THE TABLETS.¹

- x. Balancing the account (*nig-šid-ag*) of money paid (*azag-ka lal-a*); *Ka-dBa-ù* took (it) in charge (*ni-ku*); the house of the priestess of Bau (*É-nin-dingir-dBa-ù*); from the X + 31st to the X + 43^d year (inclusive) of the reign of *Dungi*, 13 years.

The tablet is too much broken to admit of complete verification. The account falls into three parts, namely:

- 1) Receipts, which make up the chief sum (*sag nig-ga-ra-kam*)², Ob. I¹—II².
- 2) Expenditures (*ša(g)-bi-ta . . . zi(g)-ga*), Ob. II³—Rev. III⁸.
 - (a) Sums which are certified by *Lù-dUtu*, Ob. II⁴—Rev. I⁶.
 - (b) Sums paid by *Lù-dUtu*, Rev. I⁷—III⁵.
 - (1) To agents from whom he holds a receipt (*a-dug dam-qar-ne-ka ba-a-gar*)³, Rev. I⁷⁻¹¹.
 - (2) For hire of the oxen and for laborers' wages (*á-gud-šù-gà á-lù-šù-gà á-ša(g)-šù*), Rev. I¹²—II²².
 - (3) In balancing an account in the name of the daughter of the king (*nig-šid-ag mu dumu-sal lugal*)⁴, Rev. II²³—III⁶.
- 3) Subscription, Rev. III⁹⁻¹⁴.
2. Barley and wood (*še-ba sig-ba*) for the gardeners of the *gišgal-gal* and for the gardeners of the vine (*nu-gišsar gišgal-gal ù nu-gišsar geštin*) for the month *Gan-maš*; in *Tig-ab-ba*, *Dungi* X + 40. The tablet is so broken that only Rev. I^{26, 27, 31, 34} of the summary can be verified. Note the use of *kal sig-a* in the summary (Rev. I^{25, 26}) and in the corresponding lines of the detailed portion (Ob. I^{2, 12, [2]0}, II^{8, 9, 25, 29}, III^{1, 5}, Rev. I¹⁸).
3. Balancing an account of oil (*nig-šid-ag iá*)⁵, which account ran from the month *Gan-maš* to *Še-il-la*, 12 months, the first year of *Bur-En-zu*.⁶ Analysis of the account:
 - 1) Receipts, Ob. I¹—II⁴.
 - (a) *iá-giš*, brought forward from the preceding year (X + 46 of *Dungi*), Ob. I¹⁻³.
 - (b) *še-giš-iá* and *iá-dun*, brought in by five men, Ob. I⁴—II¹.
 - (c) Sum total of receipts (*sag nig-ga-ra-kam*), Ob. II²⁻⁴.
 - 2) Expenditures (*ša(g)-bi-ta . . . zi(g)-ga*), Ob. II⁵—Rev. VI³.

- 3) *diri(g)*, Rev. VI⁴⁻⁵.
 4) Subscription, Rev. VI⁶⁻¹⁴. Omitting the respective quantities of sesame oil and lard, the expenditures as summarized in Rev. III⁶—V¹⁸ are as follows: 1) *nig-ku gál si-nig šutug gim-tur ù g¹³ ginar-d Ba-ù*, “the *nig-ku gál* of the *si-nig*, *šutug*, the young women, and the bark of Bau” (Rev. III⁶⁻⁸ = Ob. II⁶⁻¹⁰). 2) *d Dun-gi ezem-ma ku-a ù nig-ku lù-rim d Dun-gi-ra rim gin*, “. . . and the *nig-ku* of the messengers’ assistants of Dungi going to the messengers” (Rev. III⁹⁻¹¹ = Ob. II¹¹⁻¹⁴). 3) *ia-ba nar d Dun-gi-ra-ge-ne*, “gift of oil to the musicians of Dungi” (Rev. III¹²⁻¹⁶ = Ob. II¹⁵⁻²⁰). Note “*nig-ku* of the new year’s festival”, Ob. II²⁰. 4) *ia tūg-gi-ag kišib nu-banda uš-bar-ge-ne*, “oil . . . seal of the *nu-banda* of the weavers” (Rev. III¹⁷⁻²² = Ob. II^{21-III¹³}). 5) *ia-ba gim-uš-[bar-ge]-ne*, “gift of oil to the women weavers” (Rev. III²³—IV² = Ob. III²⁴⁻²⁵). Note that they are from *Girsu*, *Kinunir*, *Nina*, and *Tigabba* (Ob. III^{15, 17, 19}). In Ob. II²⁰ 6406 is a mistake for 6466, which is the correct sum, and the one required by Ob. II²². 6) *Kišib d Utu-gir-gal* (Rev. IV³⁻⁴ = Ob. III²⁶⁻²⁷). 7) *zi(g)-ga gír rim-ge-ne*, “paid to the *gír* of the messengers” in *Girsu*, *Ki-ku-da-qa-la*, *Huneru*, *Tigabba*, and *Kinunir* (Rev. IV⁵⁻⁶ = Ob. III²⁸—V¹⁵). 8) *bár-ag* (Rev. IV⁷⁻⁹ = Ob. V¹⁶⁻¹⁷). 9) *kaš simug-a lugal ša(g) Tūm-ma-al^{ki}*, “wine for the royal smiths in *Tummal*” (Rev. IV¹⁰⁻¹¹ = Ob. V¹⁸⁻²⁰). 10) *Na-gu-ù-du nar lugal* (Rev. IV¹²⁻¹³ = Ob. V²¹⁻²³). 11) *X²-igi É-d Nin-gir-su-ka-ge ag-ne³* (Rev. IV¹⁴⁻¹⁵ = Ob. V²⁴⁻²⁵). 12) *Bá-šá-à-lì lù-g¹³ ku* (Rev. IV¹⁶⁻¹⁷ = Ob. V²⁶⁻²⁷). 13) *Gimil-d Iškur kišib nagar alan lugal in-dim-ma*, “Gimil-Iškur, with the seal of the carpenter who made the statue of the king”. Instead of *lugal* (Rev. IV¹⁸⁻²⁰ = [Ob. V³⁰—VI²]) the name *Bur-d En-zu* occurs in a parallel passage in CT. VII 17765 II 22—23. 14) [. . .] *kù-ta ne-lal-a ù nig-àr-àr a-šà-bi* (Rev. IV²¹⁻²³ = [Ob. VI³⁻⁶]). 15) *gim-ará ki-su-udu-šù-nig-ki⁴ erin lù-ḫu-dūr-bu⁵ ù ug-il [e]-ba-ab-erin(?)* (Rev. IV²⁴⁻²⁶ = Ob. VI¹⁷⁻²¹). Rev. IV^{25a} seems to be a summary of Ob. VI¹⁷⁻¹² (6); IV^{25b} corresponds to Ob. V¹³⁻¹⁵, and IV²⁶ to Ob. VI¹⁶⁻²⁰. 16) *gim-ará giš-ku e-ku ba-ba-ab-erin(?) ša(g) é-ará* (Rev. IV²⁷—V² = Ob. VI²²⁻¹). 17) *zi(g)-ga Ma-ad-ga^{ki}* (Rev. V³⁻⁵ = [Rev. II¹⁻⁵]). 18) *diri(g) nig-šid-ag* (Rev. V⁶⁻⁷ = Rev. II⁶⁻⁸). 19) *kišib pa-te-si-ka* (Rev. V⁹⁻¹¹ = Rev. II¹²⁻¹⁹); $\frac{1}{2}$ *mana* $1\frac{1}{2}$ *gìn* $7\frac{1}{2}$ *še* of silver has the same value as 1 *gur* $76\frac{1}{2}$ *qa* of sesame oil. Note that 5 shekels of the silver was in bags (5 *gìn kù-babbar ša(g) su dug-gán-na*, Rev. II¹⁴⁻¹⁵). 20) *sag ia-nun-šù*, “oil in exchange for butter” (Rev. V¹²⁻¹³ = Rev. II²⁰⁻²¹). 21) 3 *ám dub-sar Mar-sa* (Rev. V¹⁴⁻¹⁵ = Rev. II⁹⁻¹¹). As far as can be determined in the present state of preservation of the tablet this is the only instance in which the order of the summary deviates from the order of the detailed portion. 22) *Ba-ḫar dumu Ab-ba-a a-dú(g)-a gá-gà* (Rev. V¹⁶⁻¹⁸ = Rev. III¹⁻⁵). A comparison of this summary with the detailed statement, “Ba-ḫar son of Abba has received” (*šū-ba-ti*), confirms DEIMEL’s⁷ explanation of the phrase as meaning “empfangen auf Rechnung, auf Borg”.

4. Pay roll of the administrative officers and laborers of ten (?) temples for the month *Ganmaš*, *Bur-Enzu* 2. Although no city is mentioned, it is probable that all of these temples were in Lagash.¹ They seem to be mentioned in order of rank, beginning with the temples of *Ningirsu* and of *Bau*. A number of questions arise in regard to the fifth and sixth lists. Why are the salaries in these two lists just the same? Why do they differ from the others in mentioning the names of two men who are evidently high officials, *Lugal-sig-su(d)* and *Ur-šu-ga-lam-ma*? Is it possible that these were twin temples dedicated to Dungi? *É-^aNina* is supplied provisionally in the seventh list, because Dungi rebuilt that temple in Lagash.² The traces of the wedges in the ninth list leave no reasonable doubt as to its reading.

The absence of the names of various classes of priests such as *enu*, *gala*, *gala maḥ*, *šutug*, *nin-dingir*, etc., and the fact that the terms used refer to the business side of temple administration, may warrant the conclusion that all are business or administrative officers. The *šabra*³ (in the third list, *sangu*),⁴ since he heads the list, may be regarded as the chief officer of administration, which, however, does not necessarily exclude his priestly character. The *nu-banda-gud* had supervision of the cattle; the *pisan-dub-ba* was the archivist;⁵ the *sag-tu*⁶ takes measurements of *land*⁷ in connection with a *dub-sar*, he had to do with cattle,⁸ and with barley,⁹ and may therefore perhaps be regarded as the superintendent of the men who weigh and take measurements, i. e., surveyor; the *ka-gur* was the keeper of the granary; the *dub-sar gud-apin* was the record-keeper of the oxen used in cultivation; the *nu-banda erin-na* was the overseer of the laborers; *maškim* (variant *rim* in Ob. I¹¹) was a judge's assistant;¹⁰ *engar* was the husbandman.

The estimate of the number of persons involved, namely about 783, is based upon the salary paid to a single individual. This is specified only in the case of the *nu-banda-gud* and the *engar*, who receive 20 and 15 gur respectively. We assume that 19, 16, 14, or 12 gur is the salary of one person only, but that when the amount is 8, 6, or 4 gur, one person performed two or more functions. The estimate is meant to be only approximate. (See the table on the following pages.)

5. Inventory of *é-dùl-la*¹¹ in *Gir-su^{ki}*, dated in the month *Ezen-Dun-gi*, *Bur-En-zu* 2. No. 126 of REISNER's *Tempelurkunden* is a similar inventory in which the same general order is observed, namely: objects made of metal; grain; garments and wool; fats, honey, cheese, fruits; wooden objects; miscellany.

The objects made of metal (Ob. I¹⁻¹³ = Rev. I¹⁴—II²) are: a silver boat (*má-gur kù-babbar*);¹² bronze¹³ *gal* and *sa-lum* objects; bronze *a-lá* and *á-gam*, bronze rings (*ḥar zabar*),

designated in the summary as small objects made [of bronze] (*nig dīm-m[a zaba]r tur-tur*); a copper vessel (*urudu pisán*); *urudu é-dīm*, *urudu a-lá*, and copper rings (*urudu har*), designated as small objects made of copper.

The amount of grain (*še*, *aš*, *šim*) in the detailed portion (Ob. I 14-16) does not tally with the summary (Rev. II 3), but since Ob. I 14 shows that 10+ gur of barley has been erased, and as this is the amount needed to make the two balance, one may suppose that the erasure was an after-thought and the summary was left unchanged. Note that lines 2, 8, 13 of Ob. I were never filled out.

The long list of garments (Ob. I 17-II 11) is summarised (Rev. II 4-9) under four headings as *tūg* (woolen) cloth or garments;¹ *tūg-kid nig-sig-sig*² (*nig-sig-sig* linen garments); *tūg sun*³ (old garments); *tūg-kid nig-sig-sig sun* (old *nig-sig-sig* linen garments). — The two qualities of wool are designated as *sig-sig* (wool of superior quality) and *sig-gi*⁴ (Rev. II 8-9 = Ob. II 12-16). The former includes *pusikku*⁵ wool for garments of the third quality (*sig-giš-ga-su-ag tūg 3 kam-uš*) and *sig-sig*: the latter includes *idqu*⁶

wool for woven garments (*šig-lag tūg-uš-bar*), *šu-X¹-a* wool for ordinary garments (*šig šu-X-a tūg-du*), and mukku wool (*šig-mug*).²

Fats, honey (*lál*), cheese, and fruits (Ob. II¹⁷—III⁵ = Rev. II¹⁰—¹⁸). The fats (*iá*) consist of butter (*iá-nun*) and oil (*iá-giš*) of ordinary and of superior quality.³ There is cheese (*ga-ḫar*) and cheese in baskets (*ga-pisàn + gi*);⁴ dates (*ka-lum*); white grapes (*geštin babbar*); pomegranates⁵ (*(?) giš-ma + gunu babbar*); *še-ir-gu* figs (*giš-ma še-ir-gu*).

Wood⁶ and objects made of wood (Ob. III⁵—Rev. I⁴ = Rev. II⁸—III¹⁴). Šurmēnu wood (*giš-šu-úr-me*); thrones made of rare woods, overlaid⁷ with copper, classified as good thrones (*giš-gu-za šig*) Ob. III⁶—⁹, ¹², ¹⁴—¹⁶ = Rev. II¹⁹, further described as thrones of urkarinnu⁸ wood for males and females⁹ (*giš-gu-za nitah [sal] giš-dūr urudu gar-ra*); thrones

*gub*¹ of *huluppu*² wood and of *mêsu*³ wood, thrones *ha-lu-úb al-zi-ra*, *keš-da ša-ra-lum*, *keš-da ha-lu-úb*. The more ordinary thrones are made of pomegranate (?),⁴ *šabartu* wood (*giš A-TU-GAB-LIŠ*), and a small throne of *a-gurin*⁵ wood. — There are *giš dubbin-gu-za*⁶ of pomegranate (?) and *huluppu* wood overlaid with copper; a good couch (Rev. II²² = Ob. IV²) of *mêsu* wood overlaid with copper (*giš ná mes urudu gar-ra*); the ordinary couches (Ob. IV³⁻⁷) are *giš ná dubbin gud ma + gunu urudu gar-ra*, and couches made of pomegranate (?), of *nurmû* wood (*nu-úr-ma*),⁷ *ašuhû* wood (*ù-dûr*),⁸ and *šabartu* wood. — The *giš GUB šig* (Rev. III²) was of *huluppu* wood (Ob. III¹⁹) in contradistinction to the more common *giš GUB* (Rev. III³ = Ob. IV¹). The better sort of tables (*banšur*) were of *lam*-wood⁹ (Ob. IV⁸), the wood of the others is not specified.¹⁰ — *giš ru ha-la*¹¹ was perhaps a wooden peg upon which fish were hung. — The better sort of maltu utensils (Rev. III⁷ = Ob. IV^{11, 13}) was made of *huluppu* wood¹² (*giš ma-al-tum ha-lu-úb*); *giš á-an-diš* made of *huluppu* wood . . . inlaid (?) with ivory (*giš á-an-diš ha-lu-úb gin-ba ka-am-si*¹³ *gar-ra*) is counted among the maltu utensils in Rev. III⁷; the more common ones (Rev. III⁸ = Ob. IV¹²) were made of tamarisk wood (*giš šinig*). — The better *giš KU-a-zikum šig* (Rev. III⁹ = Ob. IV¹⁴⁻¹⁸) were likewise made of rare woods¹⁴ inlaid (?) with ivory and are as follows: *giš KU-a-zikum ha-lu-úb gin-ba ka-am-si gar-ra*, *giš aš-hal-lum ha-lu-úb gin-ba ka-am-si gar-ra*, *giš KU-a-zikum ha-lu-úb*, *giš ba-ti mes-mes*, *giš qa-pur-zi šag-kal*. — There is a pair of wooden scales overlaid (?) with copper and having a copper pan (?) (*giš(e)rin urudu gar-ra liš¹⁵ bi urudu*). — The two . . . carriages (*giš ginar é-ba-an*, Rev. III¹¹) are described more fully (Ob. IV¹⁹⁻²⁰) as a fine . . . carriage (*giš ginar šu-dû¹⁶ é-ba-an*) and a small . . . one (*giš ginar tur-tur é-ba-an*). — *giš GU-BI*¹⁷ *sag-gà*: *giš TUR-SU*. — The sixteen baskets (*pisàn*, Rev. III¹⁴) are described more specifically (Rev. I²⁻⁴) as *giš pisàn tûg* [] (reed baskets for clothes [?]), *pisàn tab-ba búr-zu si(g)-ga*, and *pisàn giš si(g)-gál ù* (?) *gub* (?) *ha*.

The *duk-kur dūr-rú*¹⁸ *kaš-šam-sa* of 150, 90, and 30 qa (Rev. I⁵⁻⁷) are omitted from the summary. — *še-tu*¹⁹; *qum-X*²⁰; finger rings *si(g)-ga* (*daghar šu si(g)-ga* Rev. III¹⁷ = Rev. I^{10, 12}) and finger rings *nu-tuk* (Rev. III¹⁸ = Rev. I^{11, 13}).

"rigoles en bois"¹, "tuyaux"². In this tablet it seems to be used as the generic term including *gi^{is}sag gub*, *gi^{is}gi-na*, *gi^{is}tag*, *gi^{is}il-il*, *gi^{is}dur-dur*, *gi^{is}dar-ru*, *gi^{is}SAL + KU-ka-ša(g)*, *gi^{is}bar-bar*, *šu-tug-gid*, *gi^{is}(e)rin*, which are used in treating (? *tag*)³ woolen and linen garments and may be provisionally translated wooden utensils. *šu* or *zi(d)* *tug-gid* may refer to a kind of meal, in which case it suggests a use similar to the extraction of grease by means of fuller's earth, the peculiar properties of which are said to be due to its physical rather than to its chemical nature.

Rev. I¹²⁻¹⁹ is a graduated list of seventeen stones of diorite⁴ (*da^{ges}i*) of various weights down to 2, 1, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ of a shekel. Were these stones used for weighing?

The subscription may be translated: Utensils (?) for finishing⁵ woolen and linen garments and the diorite stones belonging to *é-šu-sum-ma* of the weaver's house.

- 4) Summary of 2).
- 5) Subscription.
7. Payment of barley to the *a-bal* and diggers (*še-ba a-bal dū-a-tar-ne*) for the months *Gan-maš* and *Har-ra-ne-mu*, *Dungi X + 46*. The grain comes from *gú id egir* and from the granary *bur-sag*, and amounts to 17 *gur* 70 *qa*. Of this 16 *gur* 60 *qa* are dispensed, leaving a balance on hand (*nig gál-la*)⁹ of 1 *gur* 10 *qa*. The irrigators (?)¹⁰ and diggers are occupied in the care of fifteen gardens or parks of which *gi^{is}šar dDun-gi-á-kalam-ma* was the largest, if one may judge from the number of men employed. Note the unidentified sign  in Ob. II²¹; *lù hul-na kab-tum* in Rev. II²⁸ and in 10 Rev. II¹⁷; most of the laborers are characterized as *sīg-a*.¹¹
8. 3 men *sīg-a* taken in charge (*ni-KU*) by *Lugal-igi-gir*; 4 men *sīg-a* taken in charge by *Lù^dNin-šubur*; in the mill (*ša(g) é-ará*); from *Ur*; month of *Amar-a-a-si*; *Bur-En-zu* 7.
9. List. *lal-li-ám*: 1 goat-herd in *Gir-su^{ki}*, 1 herdsman in *Nina^{ki}*, 1 herdsman in *Tig-ab-ba^{ki}*, 1 old (*šu (l)-gi*) shepherd in *Gir-su^{ki}*, 1 female musician *gil (nar sal gil)*, 1 door-keeper, 1 *lù-kisal*, 7 diviners (*NUN-ME-TAG = gašam*). *diri(g)*: 7 tenders of the *gi^{is}gal-gal* (*nu-gi^{is}šar gi^{is}gal-gal*) in *Nina^{ki}*.
10. Payment of barley to the diggers (*še-ba dū-a-tar-e-ne*) by *Dū-ma-nu*: *PA Gú-ú-gú-nu*: month of *Gan-maš*, *Dungi X + 46*. It is similar to no. 7 (cf. the dates!), and the gardens *dDun-gi-á-kalam-e*, *Geštin-kar-tak-ki*, and *Garaš* occur in both.

11. Allotment of barley and wool to the *a-ga-am-me*, [. . .]-^d*Dun-gi-me*, *ùg-il é-gal-me* (porters of the palace), and 20 mana of wool and 2 garments to the wife of *Lù-dBa-ù šim*. The succeeding lines must be read in the light of the first line (30 *še lugal* 3 *ma-na*), i. e., with *še lugal* understood after the first numeral of the line, and *ma-na* or *ma-na-sìg* after the second numeral; thus line 2: 15 (*še lugal*) 1½ (*ma-na*) *Lù-dBa-ù*, etc. No barley total is given, but that of the wool is correct.
12. List of those that are dead (*ù(g)*) or on half-pay (*maš*). *A-gu* is *PA*.
13. List of men working (literally, "present") on the Ningirsu canal (*id dNin-gir-su*), the 1st day of the month *Esen-Ne-gin*, *Bur-En-zu* 7.

There are six classes of laborers, namely, those with no further designation than that of laborer (*kal*), laborers on half-pay and on two-thirds pay (*kal maš*, *kal* ) , *tu(d)-kal*, *kal še-il*,¹ and *kal a-nigin-a gub-ba*.² The *kal*, *kal-maš*, and *tu(d)-kal* are divided into groups of from 4 to 18 persons, over whom a subordinate officer (*ni-kv*)³ is in charge. From three to seven of these groups or gangs and a small number of *kal še-il* and *a-nigin-na gub-ba* are under the supervision of a *PA*, so that each of the three *PA* officers has under him 49, 13, and 56 men respectively. The gangs are employed upon the earth-works (*saḥar-a gub-ba*).

There is a discrepancy of 4 in the number of *kal* between the totals in Ob. I¹¹ and in Rev. II¹, and the numbers given in Ob. I^{11.4.7}. Ob. I¹ shows an erasure with a slight suggestion that 8 may have been written there originally. *kal*  (Ob. I¹¹) is counted among the *kal-maš* in Ob. II¹ and Rev. II². In Rev. I² the writing of the numeral 4 () is peculiar. The totals in Rev. I¹⁴ and II² call for 3 *kal maš* in Rev. I⁴ instead of 2.

14. List of *he-dúr* and *ad-ge* present in the mill in *Sag-da-na* (*é-ará-a gub-ba ša(g) Sag-da-na^{ki}*) the 30th day of the month *Ezen-Dumu-zi*, *Bur-En-zu* 9. Most are on full pay, some are on half-pay, and three are women. Ob. I¹—Rev. I¹⁸ is almost identical with REISNER, *Tempelurkunden*, 139 I 1—IV 6, which is from the same year. Compare also *ibid.*, 149. The *he-dúr* comprise men of various occupations such as a fisherman, gardener, musician, *gala*, *gin-nita šabra*, *šu-il*, draper (*lù-tùg*), *edin*, *ad-ge* (!), and *dam-kàr*. In the list of *ad-ge* a *PA* is named for each man on full pay, or for a man on full pay and one on half-pay. Note the use of *mu X šù ki Y*, "for X from Y", in Ob. I¹⁰⁻¹¹, 13-14, II⁵⁻⁶; *giš-dúr-e dūr-ba* in Rev. I⁴.
15. List of *a-ga-am* of three temples, namely, *É-ur-dun* (Ob. 1-9), *É-gi-na-tum* (Ob. 10—Rev. 6), and *É-gù-pú* (Rev. 7-14). Each name is preceded by the amount (of barley and of wool) received, as in no. 11.
16. List of fifteen men added (*taḥ-ḥa-ù-ám*) to the (staff of) *É-dNin-dar-a*. Note *sa-gab nu-banda-gud-ta* (Ob. 13, Rev. 4), *sa-gab sag-tu* (Rev. 2).
17. List of the number of women on full pay, on half-pay (*gin á-maš*), without pay (*nu-dib*, literally, "not taking"), and not drawing half-pay (*nu-dib á-maš*), with the names of their respective *PA*.
18. Payment in barley of *NIGIN(?)ba* and *gin-ará* for the month *Ezen-Dumu-zi*, *Bur-En-zu* 3. There are ten gangs consisting of men, women, and children, each gang under a *PA*.

This is followed by a list classified according to scale of wage, which varies from 60 to 10 qa per capita, the sum total of barley expended, and the date.

19. Balancing the account (*nig-šid-ag*) of *Ur-šá(g)-ga*, which ran from the X + 40th year of *Dungi*. In the X + 41st year 5 gur 260 qa was brought in (*mu-túm*), leaving an unpaid balance (*lal-li*) of 8 gur 238 qa as *kišib nu-tuk*.
20. Balancing the account of *Lugal-ug¹-tur* and *Nig-^dBa-ú* in the X + 39th year of *Dungi*. The unpaid balance (*lal-li*) is to bear interest (*su-su-dam*).
21. Pay roll of *é-šim-me* (spice house), *Bur-En-zu* 2. Ob. I¹⁻¹⁴ is for the month *Gan-maš*, ¹⁵⁻²⁷ for the month *Ezen-Ne-gún*. This is followed by a summary of the rate of wage and total per month. The first list is applicable to the five months from *Gan-maš* to *Bulug-kú* inclusive, the second to the three months from *Ezen-Ne-gún* to *Bulug-kú* inclusive. The sum total is obtained by multiplying the monthly totals by 5 and 3 respectively. There is a discrepancy between Ob. ¹ and Rev. ⁵, but the totals are in agreement with the latter. The occupations mentioned are *sil-a ku-ba*, and *im-e-tak-a*.
22. *Lù-dám-mà* is to pay interest (*su-su-dam*) in the X + 38th year of *Dungi* upon the (unpaid) balance (*si-ni-ib*)² from the preceding year.
23. Balancing the account of *Ur-^dNin-giš-si-da* in the X + 46th year of *Dungi*. There is an unpaid balance from the X + 44th year of *Dungi* which is reduced by amounts paid out (*zig-ga*), Ob. I⁸—II⁸, and by amounts brought in (*mu-túm*), Ob. II⁹—Rev. II⁷. Note the expressions: *gar-è-a*, Ob. I²; *še má-a-si(g)-ga*, Ob. I³; *a-dug-a gá-gà*, Ob. I¹³; *a-dug-a ba-a-gar*, Ob. II²; *šu-ti-a*, Ob. II⁵; *gùb-bi tar-ri-dam*, Ob. II¹⁴.
24. Balancing the account of *Ur-gar* from the X + 35th to the X + 41st year of *Dungi*. There was an unpaid balance (*si-ni-ib*) of 62 gur 216⁵/₆ qa from the X + 35th and X + 37th years. Various amounts were brought in (*mu-túm*) until the unpaid balance (*lal-li*) was reduced to 10 gur 295 qa. Note that 1 gín 20 še kù was worth 266⁵/₆ qa of barley (Ob. ⁹⁻¹⁰); 10 shekels of silver (*kù-babbar*) was worth 10 gur of barley in the X + 40th year (Rev. ¹); 10 gín (of silver?) was worth 10 gur 295 qa of barley in the X + 35th year—if such is the meaning of 10 gur 295 qa 10 gín gur (Rev. ¹⁴). The ratio of kù to kù-babbar was approximately as 4:5.
25. Amounts from *Si-dū* and *Lù-kal-la* which make up the capital (*sag nig-ga-ra*).
26. A record of the barley which the workmen (*erín-e*) received (*šu-ti-a*) from *U-da*.
27. *gan* and *lum-dù-MUN* of the [*giš*]-*kin-ti gu-la* (Ob. ¹⁻³), *giš-kin-ti^d Nin-é-gal* (Ob. ⁴⁻⁷), and *giš-kin-ti nin-a-a-ba-àš* (Ob. ⁸—Rev. ²): *a-ša(g) ù-gig*. The edge gives a total of 131⁵/₁₈ ¹/₃₆ ¹/₇₂ *gan* 7¹/₃₆ *lum*, which is the sum of Ob. ¹⁻⁷, but which leaves Ob. ⁸—Rev. ¹ entirely out of account.
28. Balancing the account of *Ba-ad-da-ri*, *Bur-En-zu* 2. The account is in regard to supplies of grain from various sources and its expenditure for seed,³ wages, and [. . .].
Analysis:
1) Grain from various fields and persons, amounting to [220] gur [180 qa] (Ob. I¹⁻¹⁶).
2) Expenditure (*ša(g)-bi-ta . . . zig-ga*), Ob. II¹—Rev. I⁸.
(a) For seed and for laborers' wages for six fields, Ob. II¹—Rev. I⁸.
(b) Summary (Rev. I⁹⁻¹⁵) of 2 a) classified as for *gan apin-a* (Rev. I⁹⁻¹²), *gan bau-a* (Rev. I¹³): total amount of seed (Rev. I¹⁴) and of wages (Rev. I¹⁵).

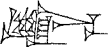

INDEX OF PROPER NAMES.

It has not been possible to make a detailed study of proper names. The index has been prepared for the convenience of those who may use this volume, but it does not purport to indicate the meaning of the names or to give their correct pronunciation. In general the same system of transcription has been employed as in THUREAU-DANGIN's *Inscriptions de Sumer et d'Akkad*, or as given by DE GENOUILLAC in his *Inventaire des Tablettes de Tello*, t. 2, pt. 2, plates 79 and 80.

Feminine names, in so far as they have been recognized as such, are followed by the sign of Venus, which is enclosed in parenthesis if the name is applied to both men and women. The occupational names and genealogical relationships are arranged and numbered under the names of persons.

The first numeral in each reference indicates the number of the tablet in this volume, the Roman and Arabic numerals indicate the column and line, respectively. An asterisk before a reference indicates that some part of the line is broken. Names that have been supplied are enclosed in brackets.
