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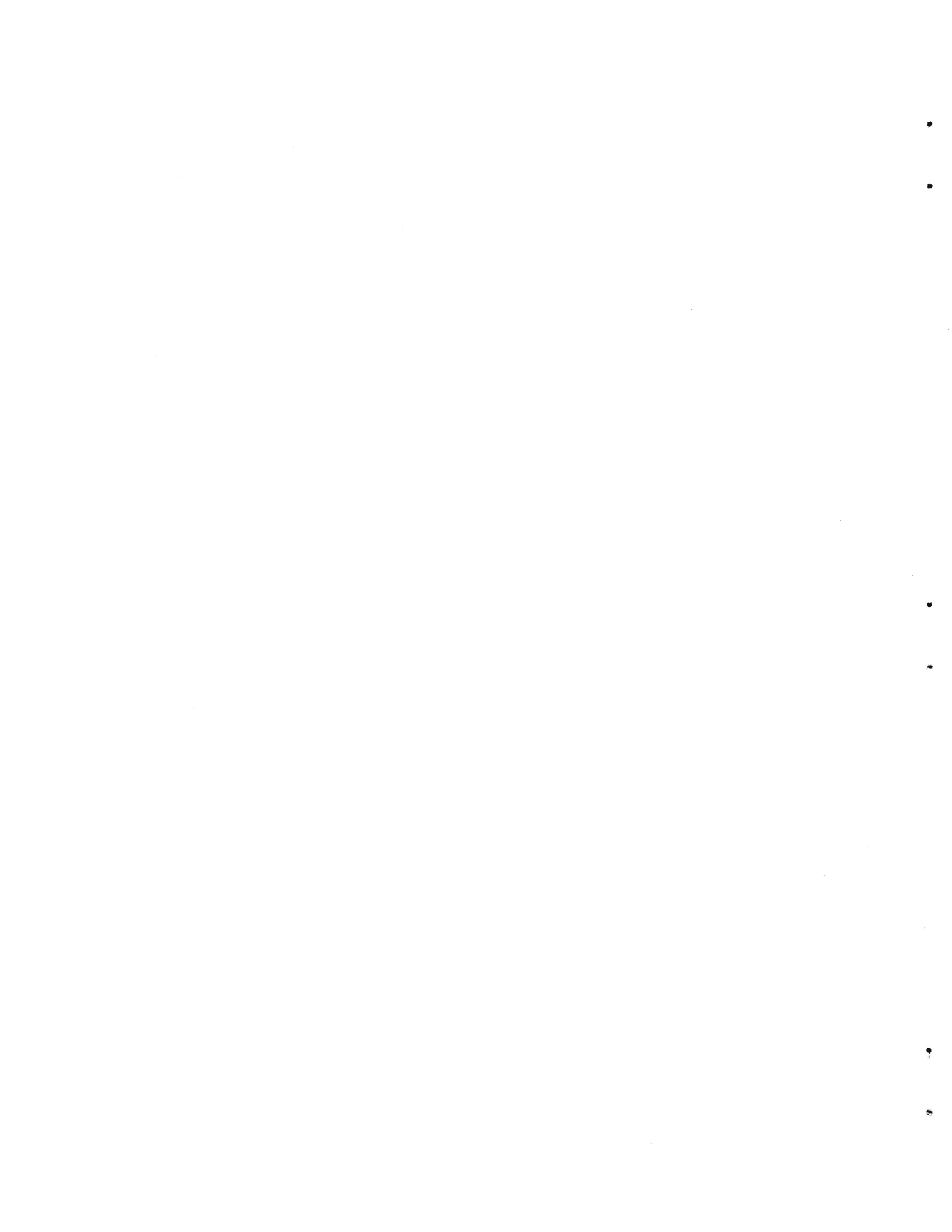
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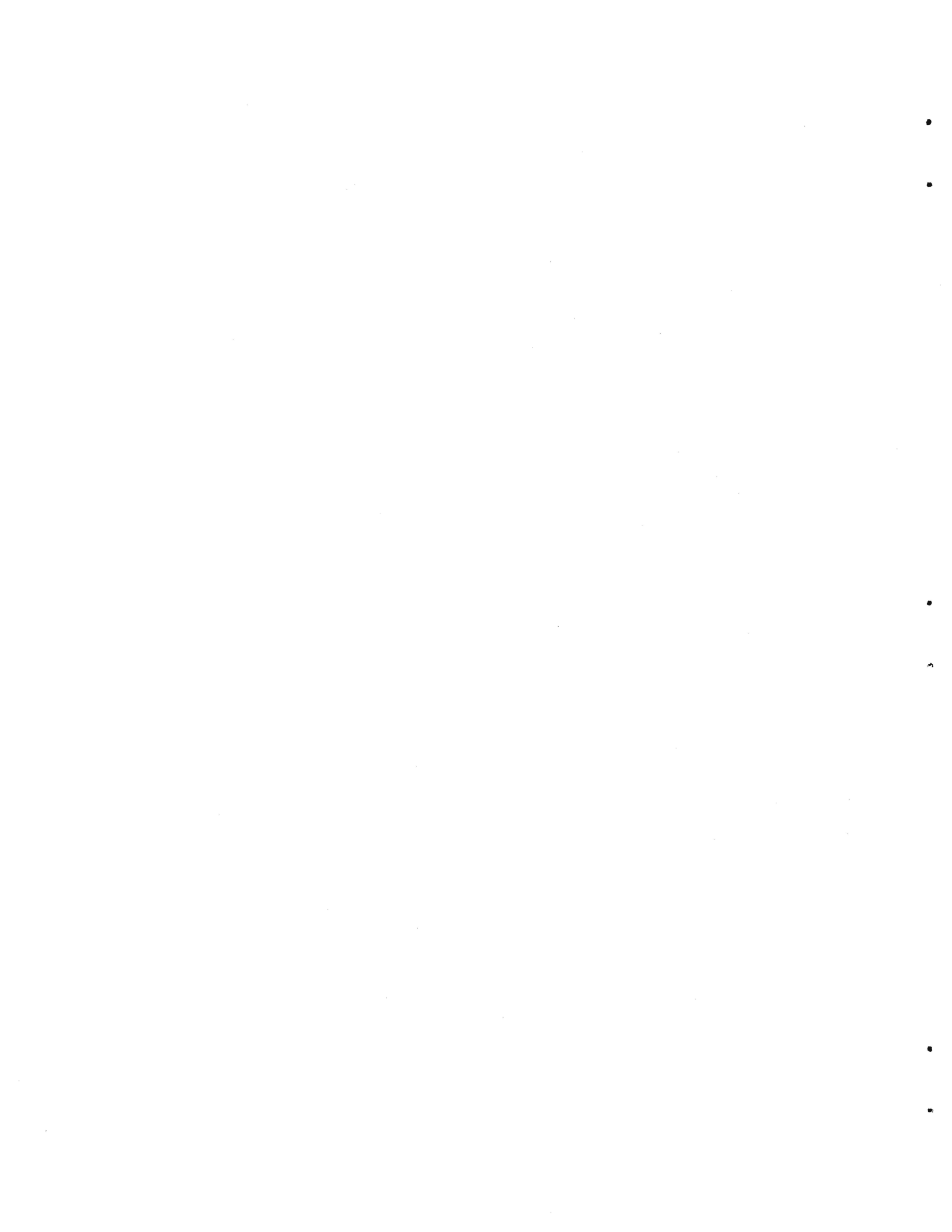
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INTRODUCTION

The following pages present highlights of the information contained in the Census Bureau's Special Population Summary prepared in accordance with Public Law 94-171.

The tabulation, which contains counts for the total population, major racial groups, and persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin, by block, tract, incorporated place, county subdivision, county and state, was intended for use in legislative reapportionment or redistricting.

The first three tables and the explanatory text describe the 1980 geographic distribution of the population by racial group and by Spanish/Hispanic origin. The last two tables and text describe the changes in the number and location of the Black population that have occurred between 1960 and 1980, by town and city, and by census tract. An additional table, indicating the 1980 racial composition and population of Spanish/Hispanic origin, by Minor Civil Division and Place has been included in the Appendix. The reader should be aware that in some instances there have been changes in community boundaries as delineated for the 1980 Census; in others, the figures are based on staff aggregations and allocations of published data.

Census Definitions

The racial and Spanish/Hispanic origin information is based entirely on self-identification. The figure for Whites comprises all persons who listed themselves as White, plus those persons who failed to indicate any specific racial category but put down Canadian, Polish, German, Lebanese, etc. That for Blacks comprises those who classified themselves as Black or listed themselves as Jamaican, West Indian, Nigerian, etc. The figure for Indians comprises those who identified themselves as American Indian, Eskimo, and Aleut or listed the name of a specific tribe; for Asian and Pacific Islanders, those who classified themselves as Chinese, Filipino, Japanese, Asian, or Guamanian. Cubans, Puerto Ricans, and Mexicans who failed to identify themselves as Black or White, as well as members of racial groups not listed elsewhere, are tabulated as "Other." Considerable confusion as to the appropriate answer to item four of the Census Questionnaire appears to be responsible for the listing of an unusually large number of persons as "Other."

Persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin may be of any race or racial mix, including Spanish, Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, Mexican-American, etc. As in the case of persons of mixed race or ethnic origin, the race of the respondent's mother is used for the purposes of classification.

RACE AND SPANISH/HISPANIC ORIGIN, 1980

Table 1 presents a summary of the 1980 population by race for the fifteen towns and cities, the two counties and the Bi-County Region. It also presents a count of the population of Spanish/Hispanic origin for the same geographic areas.

In 1980 the Bi-County population was 91.7% White, 6.2% Black, 0.1% American Indian, just under 1.0% Asian and approximately 1.0% "Other" or unclassified. Nassau County had a slightly higher percentage of Blacks and Asians, while Suffolk had a slightly higher percentage of Whites and Indians. The Towns of Hempstead, Babylon and Islip ranked first, second, and third, respectively, in number of Black residents; the Towns of Brookhaven, Hempstead, and Islip ranked first, second, and third, respectively, in number of Indian residents; and the Towns of Hempstead, North Hempstead, and Oyster Bay ranked first, second, and third, respectively, in number of Asian residents. A Minority map which indicates minorities as a percent of total population (minorities defined as Black, American Indian, Asian, White Hispanics and Others) has been included at the end of the volume.

In Nassau, Blacks accounted for as much as 9.7% of the total population in the City of Long Beach and as little as 1.2% in the Town of Oyster Bay. In Suffolk they accounted for as much as 13.9% of the total in the Town of Babylon and as little as 0.4% in the Town of Shelter Island. Except in the Town of Southampton, where the Shinnecock Reservation raised the Indian count to 0.7% of the town total, Indians constituted less than 0.3% of the population of all Nassau and Suffolk municipalities. Asians constituted a somewhat larger fraction of the total in five municipalities -- the Town of North Hempstead, the City of Glen Cove, the Town of Oyster Bay, the Town of Huntington, and the Town of Brookhaven -- where they accounted for from 1.0% to 2.2%.

Table 1 indicates that in 1980 there were 101,975 Bi-County inhabitants of Spanish/Hispanic origin. Of this group 43,286 persons or 42.4% resided in Nassau County and 58,689 persons or 57.6% resided in Suffolk County. Hispanics comprised nearly 3.3% of the total population in Nassau and nearly 4.6% in Suffolk.

The Town of Hempstead, with 25,486 persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin accounted for close to three fifths of the Nassau total, while the Town of Islip, with 26,259 persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin accounted for a little more than two fifths of the Suffolk total. In Nassau the geographic distribution of the Hispanic population was more or less proportionate to the distribution of the population as a whole in the towns of Hempstead and North Hempstead. It was disproportionately high in the two cities and disproportionately low in the Town of Oyster Bay. In Suffolk, the Town of Islip reported a disproportionately large share -- 44.7% of the County's Hispanic population -- but only 23.3% of the total population. The town share of the Hispanic population was only slightly lower than its share of the total population in Babylon and Brookhaven, but was far lower than the share of the total population in the seven remaining towns.

Table 2 provides a somewhat crude but nonetheless revealing indication of the geographic distribution of the Bi-County Black population and of the changes that have occurred during the past twenty years.

In Nassau there is a significant and apparently increasing concentration of the Black population. In 1960 ten percent of the census tracts accounted for 28,960 persons or 73.6% of all Black residents. In 1980 ten percent of the census tracts accounted for 74,134 persons or 81.7%. Similarly, in 1960 20% of the census tracts accounted for 87.3% of the Black population; in 1980 20% accounted for 94.8% of the Black population. In both years, only 30% of the 220 census tracts accommodated more than 90% of the County's Black residents.

In Suffolk the Black population appears to be somewhat more widely distributed. In 1960 ten percent of the census tracts accounted for 19,632 persons or 59.4% of the total. In 1980 ten percent of the census tracts accounted for 42,216 persons, and a slightly lower, 58.8% share of the total. Similarly, in 1960 20% of the census tracts accounted for 77.5% of the Black population; in 1980 20% accounted for a slightly lower 76.4%. The relatively insignificant decreases in percentage of the population may be attributable to sharp reductions in institutional concentrations. In both years 40% of the 110 census tracts accommodated more than 90% of the County's Black residents.

Table 3 deals with the geographic or spatial distribution of persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin. The Hispanic population generally appears to be more widely dispersed than the Black population, particularly in Nassau County.

Despite the sizeable concentrations in such places as the Village of Hempstead, where one census tract accounted for more than 1000 Hispanics and two adjacent tracts more than 1000 persons and one, 500 - 999 persons; and the City of Glen Cove, where two tracts each accounted for 500 - 999 persons, ten percent of the Nassau census tracts accounted for only 33.9% of the County Total. Twenty percent of the census tracts accommodated just under half, 49.7%; and half of the tracts, just over three quarters of Nassau's Hispanic population.

The major concentrations of Hispanic residents are somewhat larger in Suffolk, where four Brentwood census tracts and two Central Islip tracts each accounted for more than 1000 persons and nine other tracts in the Brentwood - Central Islip area each accounted for 500 - 999 persons. Ten percent of the Suffolk census tracts accounted for 40.9% of the County total. Twenty percent accommodated 57.3%, and half of the census tracts accommodated 83.5% of Suffolk's Hispanic population.

Charts 1 and 2, which depict the distribution of the 1980 Black and Hispanic populations of Nassau and Suffolk Counties, provide a clear illustration of the differences in settlement patterns by County and minority group.

DISTRIBUTION OF BLACK POPULATION 1980

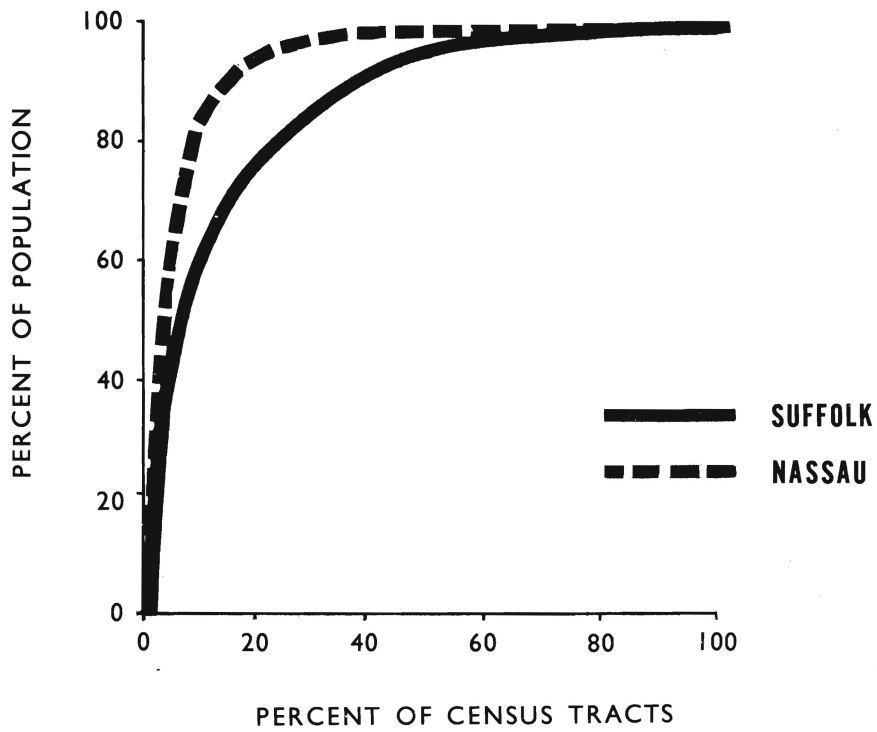
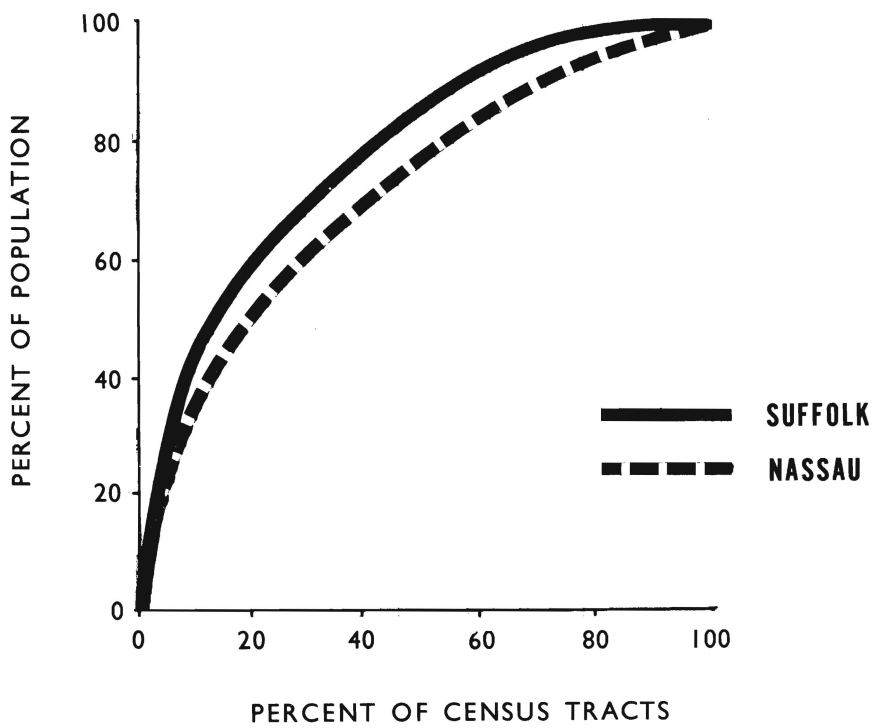


CHART 2.

COMPARABILITY OF DATA

Any analysis of changes in the composition or characteristics of the population over time is necessarily constrained by the comparability of the data.

Variations in small area geographic coverage occur as a result of municipal incorporations and annexations and of Census Bureau alterations in the boundaries of Census Designated Places.

Changes in subject definitions are surprisingly frequent as federal and other user demands for data and data collection and tabulation methods continue to evolve. In 1960, the Census listed only three major racial categories: White, Negro, and Other. In 1980, the Census listed White, Black, American Indian, Asian, and Pacific Islander, and Other. In 1970, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, and Mexicans who failed to specify their race were classified as White; in 1980, this same group was classified as Other.

In 1960 and 1970, demographic information respecting persons of Spanish/Hispanic origin was based upon a sample rather than a full count and was not only extremely limited but frequently subject to suppression in order to avoid disclosure. In 1980, 100% rather than sample data, plus a broader definition of the category provided more complete and useful information.

Comparison is further complicated by the fact that the revisions of the initial 1970 population figures have been made available for the population as a whole, but are not reflected in the small area tabulations of demographic characteristics.

In the Nassau-Suffolk area, there are only two racial groups, White and Black; two sets of data, those for 1960 and those for 1980; and two types of small area geographic unit, Minor Civil Divisions (Towns and Cities) and Census Tracts for which the statistics have been unaffected by changes in definition, known errors in tabulations, or revisions of boundaries.

Since the changes in the White component of the population so closely resemble those of the population as a whole, the following analysis is limited to the changes in the number and distribution of the Bi-County's Black residents.

THE BLACK POPULATION 1960 - 1980

As indicated by the figures in Table 4, there have been significant changes in both the size and distribution of the Black population since 1960.

In the region as a whole, the number of Black residents increased from 72,385 in 1960 to 162,484 in 1980. The relative growth of the Black component, 124.5% exceeded the 32.5% gain reported for the total population. The Nassau County Black population count rose from 39,350 to 90,743 persons or 130.6% while the total population increased from 1,300,171 to 1,321,582 persons -- only 1.6%. The Suffolk County Black population count rose from 33,035 to 71,741 persons or 117.2%, while the total population increased from 666,784 to 1,284,231 persons or 92.6%.

The Black share of the population more than doubled in Nassau County, from just over 3.0% to almost 6.9%. In Suffolk, where the Black population accounted for nearly 5.0% of the total in 1960, the Black share rose to 5.6% an increase of only 12.9%. Several factors appear to offer at least a partial explanation of the differences in the pattern of change in the two counties. The virtual cessation of white in-migration to Nassau County by the beginning of the 1970's; the aging of the population, which was accompanied by a reduction in births and the out-migration of young adults and retirees, and, ultimately, a net loss in population; and the existence of a number of established Black communities that expanded to accommodate new residents -- all combined to produce the sizeable increases in the number of Blacks and the Black percent of the population in the western county. The large scale in-migration to Suffolk County, which has slowed only recently, seems to have contributed to a substantial increase in

the number of Black residents, but little change in the size of the Black share of the population.

Within Nassau County, the Town of Hempstead recorded the largest absolute increase in the number of persons, 43,300; the City of Long Beach, with a smaller base population, recorded the largest relative increase, 194.5%. The Town of Hempstead gained nearly ten times as many additional Black residents as did the Town of North Hempstead, the municipality with the second largest increase. Only the City of Glen Cove reported a decrease both in the number of Black residents and in the relative size of the Black population.

Within Suffolk County, the Town of Babylon recorded the largest absolute increase in the number of Black residents, 16,851 persons; the Town of Brookhaven, the largest relative increase 222.2%. The Town of Islip, which lost more than 3,000 Black patients and resident staff at two State hospitals, reported a net gain of 9,440 persons or 145.8% while the Town of Huntington, the only other town to report a significant increase, added 4,144 persons or 158.7%.

In three municipalities, the Town of Brookhaven, the Town of Riverhead, and the Town of Southampton, the increase in the number of Blacks was accompanied by a decrease in the relative size of the Black component of the population. Most of the gains in the number of Blacks occurred in the Towns of Babylon, Islip, and Brookhaven, which together accounted for 89.2% of the county-wide growth.

Three municipalities, the Towns of Shelter Island, Smithtown, and Southold recorded decreases in the number of Blacks and in the size of the Black component

of the population. The Shelter Island decrease is insignificant; the Smithtown decrease is largely hospital related; and the Southold decrease appears to be due to a reduction in the number of resident agricultural workers and the aging of the local Black population.

Table 5 lists the twenty Nassau and twenty Suffolk census tracts with the greatest number of Black residents in 1960 and in 1980.

The tracts are ranked from one to twenty according to the size of the Black population. Examination of this table reveals that in spite of some major shifts in rank order, twelve of the top twenty tracts in each county in 1960 also appear among the top twenty in 1980.

Of the twelve tracts in Nassau, two are located in the Village of Hempstead; two in Roosevelt; and two, in the Village of Freeport. Single tracts are located in New Cassel, the Village of South Floral Park, Lakeview, Uniondale, Inwood, and the City of Long Beach. The 1980 additions comprise four census tracts located in the Village of Hempstead; one, in Baldwin; one, in the Village of Freeport; and one, in West Amityville.

Of the twelve tracts in Suffolk, two are located in North Amityville and two, in Wyandanch. Single tracts are located in Huntington Station, Greenlawn, North Bay Shore, Coram, Center Moriches, Riverhead hamlet, Flanders and in the eastern portion of the Town of Southampton. The 1980 additions include two tracts located in Central Islip and one each, in Deer Park, Brentwood, North Bay Shore, North Great River, Coram, and North Bellport.

Note 1: Hispanics are an ethnic group and not a race. Hispanics are therefore included in the five racial categories.

Note 2: The "other" category is inaccurate since a large number of Hispanics incorrectly classified themselves in that category.

Note 3: The total minority population cannot be determined from this table because Hispanics classified in racial minorities would be double counted. The map included in this volume separates the Hispanics into racial categories to obtain a total minority representation.
