
Shell Suspends Drilling for Arctic Ocean in 2013 "We've made progress in Alaska, but this is a long-term program that we are pursuing in a safe and measured way," Shell Oil Co. President Marvin Odun said in the announcement. "Our decision to pease in 2013 will give us time to ensure the readiness of all our equipment and people following the drilling season in 2012." Environmental groups opposed to drilling cheered the announcement. "This is the first good decision we've seen from Shell," said Mike LeVine, an Alaska spokesman for Oceana. "Given the disastrous 2012 season, our government agencies must take advantage of this opportunity to reassess the way decisions are made about our ocean resources and to reconsider the commitment to explore for all in the Arctic Ocean."
